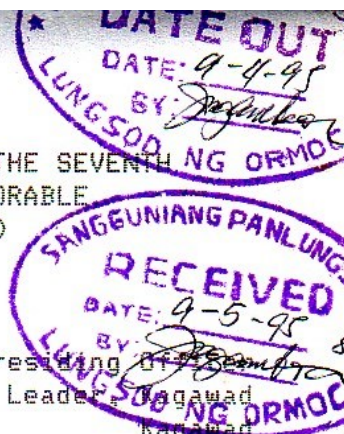
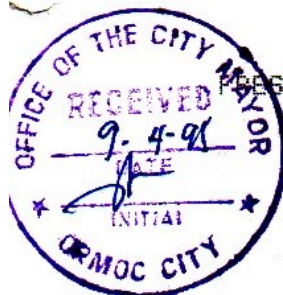

RESOLUTION NO. 95-51

WHEREAS, at present there is an artificial shortage of palay, rice and corn brought about by the export or outflow of rice from Ormoc City to its neighboring municipalities which triggered the shortage and the spiralling of their prices;

WHEREAS, the provision of R.A. 7581 empowers LGU to adopt measures which will stabilize the prices of palay, rice and corn and other foodstuffs and protect consumers;

WHEREAS, Sec. 16 of the Local Government Code, otherwise known as the General Welfare Clause empowers LGUs to exercise "X X X powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective government and these which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare";

WHEREAS, the Task Force on the Monitoring and Stabilizing of the Prices of Basic Necessities and Prime Commodities in the meeting last August 21, 1995, has recommended to control the export and/or outflow of palay, rice and corn outside the territorial jurisdiction of Ormoc City;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Sotero M. Pepito, Chairman, Committee on Good Government & Ethics, jointly seconded by mga Kagawad Benjamin B. Lladoc and Alfredo F. Capahi; be it

RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 50

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE EXPORT OR OUTFLOW OF PALAY, RICE AND CORN OUTSIDE THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF ORMOC CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Seventh Sangguniang Panlungsod, that:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to ship out and/or transport or export palay or milled rice or corn, in any form in excess of 10 cavans or its equivalent, outside the jurisdiction of Ormoc City without written clearance from the Office of the City Mayor.

SECTION 2. Any person or persons who shall ship, transport or export the aforementioned commodities without the necessary clearance shall be stopped from shipping, transporting or exporting the same and shall have the said commodities impounded and deposited with the National Food Authority who shall take the appropriate legal action in accordance with this ordinance.

SECTION 3. Any person who violates the provision of this ordinance shall suffer an imprisonment of not exceeding one (1) year or fine not exceeding Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) or both imprisonment and fine at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 4. The implementation of this ordinance is automatically suspended when the crisis has abated as determined by the City Mayor upon recommendation of the task force on the Monitoring and Stabilizing of the Prices of Basic Necessities and Prime Commodities.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon approval.

SECTION 6. For purposes of complying with the provisions of Section 511 of Rep. Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, at least three (3) copies of this Ordinance be posted each at the City Hall, the Executive building and at the Sangguniang Panlungsod for a minimum of three (3) consecutive weeks.

ENACTED, August 31, 1995.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish copies of this resolution-ordinance, one each, to His Honor, the City Mayor; the City Administrator, the City Legal Officer, the City Treasurer, Big and Small Rice Dealers, the City Prosecutors' Office, the MTCC Office, the Regional Trial Court, the Superintendent (City Director)- PNP Ormoc City Police Command, the City Social Welfare & Development Office, the Public Market Administrator's Office, the GSD Office, Civic Clubs/Organizations, -all in Ormoc City;

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
