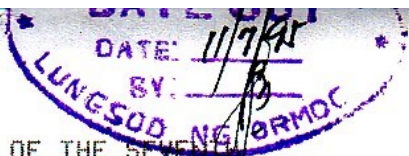


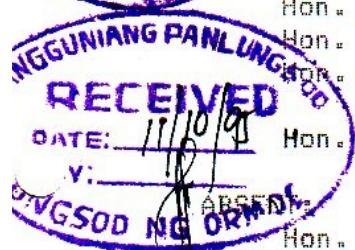

RESOLUTION NO. 95-114

WHEREAS, obviously, Ormoc City is in the threshold of economic progress and inevitably, along with this progress, comes the increase in population and the proliferation of conveyances, both public and private causing a chaotic and congested traffic situation in the city;

WHEREAS, however, with our existing laws and city ordinances (Ord. No. 9 as amended by Ord. No. 14 s. 1977), our city has enough safety nets, albeit some may be obsolescent and therefore need supplementary amendments particularly Sec. 3 of Ordinance No. 14 which is hereunder cited as follows:

"SECTION 3. TRAFFIC GENERATORS. - All traffic generating buildings and structures allowed in any district must provide for adequate parking spaces for their employees, clients and visitors;"

WHEREAS, the need to amend and/or supplement Zoning Ordinance No. 14 is therefore necessary so as to alleviate the traffic situation here in this city;

WHEREFORE, premises considered, on motion of Kagawad Jose C. Alfaro, Jr., Chairman, Committee on Police, Fire and Public Safety, severally seconded by mga Kagawad Claudio P. Larrazabal, Sotero M. Pepito and Alfredo F. Capahi; be it

RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 51

AN ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTING ORDINANCE NO. 14, SERIES OF 1977 BY REQUIRING OWNERS, PROPRIETORS, MANAGERS, OFFICE-IN-CHARGE AND/OR PERSON OR PERSONS RESPONSIBLE OF BUILDING(S), STORE(S), BANK(S), OFFICE(S), HOTEL(S),



INNS, BOARDING OR LODGING HOUSES, MOTEL(S), RESTAURANT(S) AND LIKE ESTABLISHMENTS TO UTILIZE OR TO MAKE AVAILABLE THE SPACES IN FRONT OF AND/OR BESIDE THE AFOREMENTIONED ESTABLISHMENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 1 (A-D) AND SECTION 3, ARTICLE VI OF ORDINANCE NO. 14 SERIES OF 1977 AND AS PROVIDED FOR IN THEIR RESPECTIVE BUILDING PERMITS AND/OR OCCUPANCY PERMITS; AND AMENDING FURTHER THE PROVISION ON THE FEES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any owner(s), proprietor(s), manager(s), office-in-charge, and/or any person(s) responsible of building(s), store(s), bank(s), office(s), hotel(s), hostel(s), inn(s), motel(s), restaurant(s), boarding or lodging house(s) or any similar establishments to utilize and/or make available the spaces in front of, and/or beside the aforementioned establishments for purposes other than those specified or allowed in Ordinance No. 9 as amended by Ordinance No. 14 and their respective Building Permits and/or occupancy permits;

SECTION 2. PENALTIES. Any of the aforementioned responsible person or persons who shall violate or cause the violation of this Ordinance as decided by a competent court, shall pay a fine of not less than P2,500.00 but not more than P5,000.00 and/or revocation of their business permit at the discretion of the court.

If, however, the responsible person does not contest the alledge violation but instead admits the same, an administrative fine of P2,000.00 shall be paid to the Office of the City Treasurer who shall issue an official receipt therefor; and for the violator to effect the immediate correction of the said violation within 15 days otherwise the same will be demolished by the City Engineer's Office at the expense of the owner.

SECTION 3. ENFORCEMENT. For purposes of this ordinance, the agency charged with the enforcement thereof shall be the City Licensing Division in coordination with the City Planning and Development Office; provided however that the Ormoc City Police Command shall on their own enforce the same with respect to violations affecting the traffic.

SECTION 4. Nothing in this Ordinance shall affect prior existing right before the enactment of Ordinance No. 14 - (Zoning Ordinance of Ormoc City).

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any part of this Ordinance is declared contrary to law or unconstitutional the same shall not invalidate this whole ordinance.

SECTION 6. REPEAL. Any Ordinance, Rules and Regulations or Executive Order contrary to this ordinance shall be deemed amended or repealed.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after posting of the copies of this ordinance at the City Hall, Executive Building and Sangguniang Panlungsod.

ENACTED, November 3, 1995.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish copies of this Resolution-Ordinance each to His Honor, the City Mayor and its Licensing Division Office; the City Police Director, Ormoc City Police Command, Police Precinct I, Police Precinct II; the City Planning and Development Coordinator, the City Engineer, the City Prosecutors Office, the Municipal Trial Courts in Cities and others concerned, -all in Ormoc City.
