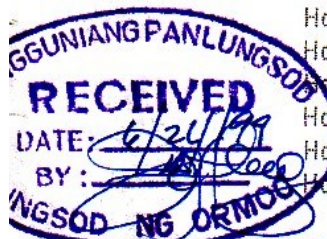

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Rules and Regulations Implementing the Local Government Code of 1991 has granted authority to the LGU's concern to temporarily or permanently close or open any road, alley park or square within its jurisdiction through an Ordinance. (Rule VIII, Art. 43 of the Rules and Regulations Implementing the Local Government Code).

The Rules further enumerates the instances wherein an LGU may temporarily close any national or local road, alley park or square, the duration of which shall be specified by the Local Chief Executive concerned in a written order as provided for under Art. 45 par. (b) quoted hereunder as follows:

"Art. 45. Temporary Closure. -

(b) An LGU may temporarily close and regulate the use of any local street, road, thoroughfare, or public place where shopping malls, Sunday markets, flea or night markets, or shopping areas may be established and where goods, merchandise, foodstuff, commodities, or articles of commerce maybe sold and dispensed to the general public."

Relying on the aforementioned provisions of the Rules and Regulations Implementing the Local Government Code, the Honorable City Mayor of Ormoc through a letter has requested this august Body for the passage of an Ordinance temporarily closing part of Burgos, Malacadios and Maca-asin streets, this city;

FOREGOING PREMISES CONSIDERED, on motion of City Councilor Nepomuceno P. Aparis I, Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, duly seconded by City Councilor Sotero M. Pepito; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass and enact:

ORDINANCE NO. 71

AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY CLOSING PART OF CERTAIN STREETS OF ORMOC CITY, WHERE GOODS, MERCHANDISE, FOODSTUFF, COMMODITIES, OR ARTICLES OF COMMERCE MAY BE SOLD AND DISPENSED TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Eighth Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, That:

SECTION 1. The portion of Burgos Street, this city beginning from corner of Bonifacio Street up to the corner of J. Navarro Street (near the City Hall) and the portion of Malacadios Street from corner of Ifaki Larrazabal Street to Maca-asin Street (at the back of City Hall) and Maca-asin Street, beginning from corner Malacadios Street (at the back of the City Hall) to J. Navarro St., this city, shall be temporarily closed to be used as place where goods, merchandise, foodstuff, commodities or articles of commerce may be sold and dispensed to the General public, the duration of which shall be as determined by the City Mayor.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

ENACTED, June 24, 1999.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, to furnish copies of this Ordinance one each to His Honor, the City Mayor; the City Administrator, the City Legal Officer and sufficient copies thereof be posted on Bulletin Boards at conspicuous places, -all in Ormoc City;
