EXPLANATORY NOT

This august body is in receipt of the 1st Indorsement dated 1 March 2000 from the Honorable City Mayor Eufrocino M. Codilla, Sr., of the letter with englosures of Engr. Conrado D. Escobar, Project Manager II, PMO-Major Flood Control Project Field Office, Fourth Leyte Engineering District, DPWH, Ormor City requesting for the closure of Lilia Avenue from F. Ablen St. to Antiao (Cantubo) Bridge on March 20, 2000 to give may for the construction of channel where the existing river course will be realigned/diverted permanently.

t can be recalled that the Rules and Regulations Implementing the ocal Government Code of 1991 has granted authority to the LGU's concern temporarily or permanently close or open any road, alley park or square within its jurisdiction through an Ordinance. (Rule VIII, Art. 43 RRILG).

The Rules further enumerate the instances wherein an LGU may temporarily close any national or local road, alley park or square, the duration of which shall be specified by the Local Chief Executive concerned in a written order as provided for under Art. 45 par (a) sub par (3) quoted hereunder as follows:

"Art. 45 Temporary Closure. (a) Any national or local road, alley, park, or square may be temporarily closed during actual emergency or fiesta celebrations, public rallies, agricultural or industrial fairs, or undertaking of public works and highways, telecommunications, and water works projects, the duration of which shall be specified by the local chief executive concerned in a written order, as follows:

X X X (3) When public works projects or activities are being undertaken for a period as may be determined necessary for the safety, security, health, or welfare of the public or when such closure is necessary to facilitate completion of the projects or activities."

FOREGOING PREMISES CONSIDERED, on motion of City Councilor Nepomuceno P. Aparis, I, Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, jointly seconded by Councilors Dennis Y. Capuyan and Sotero M. Pepito; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass an enact:

ORDINANCE NO. 77

AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY CLOSING PART OF LILIA AVENUE, FROM F. ABLEN STREET TO ANILAO (CANTURO) BRIDGE, FROM MARCH 20, 2000 UNTIL SUCH TIME THAT THE NEW ANILAO BRIDGE WILL BE OPEN TO TRAFFIC.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the EIGHTH SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD NG ORMOC, that:

SECTION 1. The portion of Lilia Avenue from F. Ablen Street up to the Anilao (Captubo) Bridge this city, shall be temporarily closed to traffic to give way for the construction of the channel where the existing river course will be realigned/diverted permanently as part of the Ormoc City Flood Mitigation Project (Phase II).

SECTION 2. DURATION OF THE CLOSURE. The portion referred to in Section 1 hereof shall be closed effective March 20, 2000 until such time the new Anilao Bridge will be open to traffic.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

ENACTED, March 16, 2000.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, to furnish copies of this Ordinance one each to His Honor, the City Mayor; the City Administrator, the City Legal Officer, the City Engineer, the City Planning and Development Coordinator, the Ormoc City Police Director, the Traffic Chief, Traffic Management Office, Ormoc PNP, Engr. Conrado D. Escobar, Project Manager II, PMO-Major Flood Control Project Field Office, Fourth LED, DPWH, Ormoc City and others concerned, -in Ormoc City.
