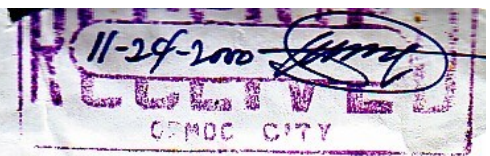


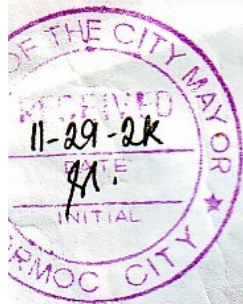

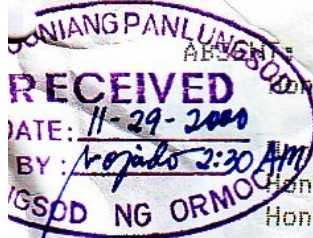


EXCERPT FROM THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE EIGHTH

EXPLANATORY NOTE

A petition has been filed by the Ormoc City Motorcab Operators and Drivers Association (OCMODA) asking for a ONE PESO (P1.00) fare increase in view of the continued increase in the prices of gasoline and other petroleum products.

The present fare for tricycles was approved sometime October 5, 1999, petitioner at that time asked for a FIFTY CENTAVOS (P0.50) fare increase and with the latest development in the oil industry wherein prices of which keep on increasing, it is also expected that operators of motorcabs have to increase the rentals on boundaries of their units to cope up with the rising prices of spare parts reducing thereby the income of motorcab drivers, thus, making it very difficult for them to make both ends meet.

The Committee has agreed to fix the rate outside the city proper on per kilometer basis it being fair, just and realistic.

WHEREFORE, on motion of City Councilor Eduardo P. Tan, Chairman, Committee on Transportation and Communications, duly seconded by City Councilor Mariano Y. Corro; be it

RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 82

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE III OF ORDINANCE NO. 34 S. 1992, AS AMENDED, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING GUIDELINES, STANDARDS, RULES AND

REGULATIONS, FOR THE OPERATIONS OF MOTORIZED TRICYCLES-FOR-HIRE AND THE ISSUANCE OF MOTORIZED TRICYCLE OPERATORS' PERMIT OR MTOP THEREBY IMPLEMENTING THE DEVOLUTION OF LTFRB'S FRANCHISING OVER TRICYCLES-FOR-HIRE TO THE CITY GOVERNMENT PURSUANT TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991 (R.A. 7160)".

BE IT ORDAINED, by the EIGHTH SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD ng ORMOC in Session, that:

SECTION 1. Article III of Ordinance No. 34 as amended is hereby further amended to read as follows;

"ARTICLE III - FARES:

The fares shall be established at a level that will provide the operator a reasonable return, or profit, and still be affordable to the general public.

The new fare rates shall be an additional Fifty centavos (P.50) of the existing rate within the city proper and forty centavos (P.40) per kilometer, outside city proper. The City proper shall comprise Barangay Districts 1 to 28.

Until such time that the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall prescribe otherwise, the official rate shall be in accordance with the following:

The foregoing schedule of fare rates should be posted prominently at the tricycle terminal, if any, and in a conspicuous part of the tricycle where said schedule can be easily seen by the passenger thereof.

Failure to observe this requirement constitute a violation of this Ordinance thereby making the operator and/or the driver of the tricycle liable to the penalty provided herein.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after its publication once in a local newspaper of general circulation within the City of Ormoc.

ENACTED, November 23, 2000.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish copies of this Ordinance, one each to His Honor, the City Mayor; the City Administrator, the City Legal Officer, the City Treasurer, Permits & Licensing Division, the PNP City Director, the PNP Precinct Commander I, the ABC President (with request to give information to the different Barangay Chairman), the DILG-City Director, the Barangay Affairs Office, the City Prosecutors Office, the OCNODA, all other concerned, and at least three (3) copies be posted on Bulletin Boards at conspicuous places, all in Ormoc City;
