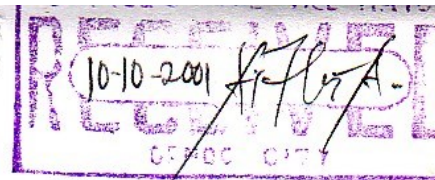

PREFATORY STATEMENT

Rizal Street, Ormoc City from its corner on C. Aviles Street northward up to its opposite corner on Osmeña Street was declared one-way traffic at all times pursuant to Ordinance No. 81 series of 1968 passed by the 6th Municipal Board on December 18, 1968. The reason for the declaration was the convenience and safety of market goers since at that time the City Public Market was located at Rizal Street.

In 1979 when the City Public Market was transferred to the reclamation area at Sabang Beach, Ormoc City, upon recommendation of the Traffic Officer of the Integrated National Police, the 1st Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc passed Ordinance No. 22, series of 1979 restoring Rizal Street to two-way traffic. Rizal Street, however, remained one-way traffic. There was no ordinance passed restoring it to a one-way street. The one-way traffic was even extended to Ebony Street.

The use of Rizal Street as one-way traffic from corner of Ebony Street northward to corner of Osmeña Street cannot be continued without an ordinance declaring it to be so. Hence, the necessity for the passage of this ordinance.

WHEREFORE, on motion of City Councilor Nepomuceno P. Aparis I, Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, jointly seconded by City Councilors Fernando P. Parrilla and Demosthenes F. Tugonon; be it

RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 84

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AS ONE-WAY TRAFFIC AT ALL TIMES THE PORTION OF RIZAL STREET FROM ITS CORNER ON EBONY STREET NORTHWARD UP TO THE CORNER OF OSMEÑA STREET AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the 9th SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD ng ORMOC, That:

SECTION 1. The following portion of the city street is hereby declared as one-way traffic at all times in the manner or direction provided hereunder, viz:

Rizal Street-from its corner on Ebony Street northward up to its opposite corner on Osmeña Street.

SECTION 2. Any violation of the provision of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) or an imprisonment of 5 to 10 days or both such fine or imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 3. Any ordinance or provision thereof in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.

ENACTED, October 09, 2001.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to direct the Chief of Police of Ormoc City to coordinate with the City Engineer in putting up the necessary traffic signs as many as possible in conspicuous places and/on corners abutting Rizal Street for purposes of this ordinance.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, to furnish copy of this ordinance each to the Municipal Trial Court in Cities, the City Prosecution Office, the Chief of Police, the City Engineer, the City Treasurer, and the Land Transportation Office, all of Ormoc City.

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
