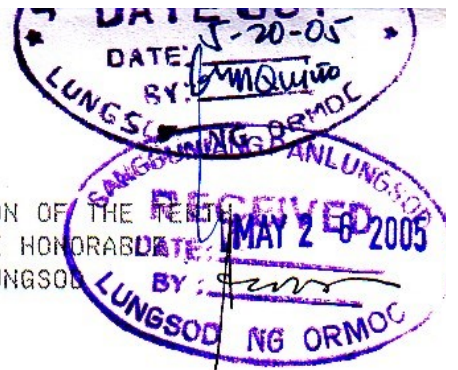

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Local Government Units are empowered, under the Rules and Regulations Implementing the Local Government Code of 1991, particularly Rule VIII, Article 43 thereof, to temporarily or permanently close or open any road, alley, park or square within its jurisdiction through an ordinance.

Article 45 of the said Implementing Rules and Regulations enumerates the instances whereby a Local Government Unit may close any national or local road, alley, park or square, the duration of which shall be determined by the local chief executive concerned in a written order, letter (b) of said article provides:

"Art. 45. Temporary Closure -

- (b) An LGU may temporarily close and regulate the use of any local street, road, thoroughfare, or public place where shopping malls, Sunday markets, flea or night markets, or shopping areas may be established and where goods, merchandise, foodstuff, commodities, or articles of commerce may be sold and dispensed to the general public."

Thus the Office of the City Mayor through 1st Indorsement dated 19 April 2005 has indorsed the request of the Ormoc City Fiesta Executive Committee 2005 to allow them to utilize some areas specified hereunder for the different trade exhibits from May 15, 2005 to July 15, 2005;

Further, in an indorsement dated 18 May 2005, the Office of the City Mayor requested on an urgent basis, the passage of said proposed ordinance for temporary closure of some areas/streets on Second and Third Reading;

FOREGOING PREMISES CONSIDERED, on motion of City Councilor Manuel T. Fiel, Vice Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, duly seconded by City Councilor Claudio P. Larrazabal; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass and enact:

ORDINANCE NO. 120

AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY CLOSING SOME AREAS/STREETS OF THIS CITY FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SHOPPING AREA WHERE GOODS, MERCHANDISE, FOODSTUFF, COMMODITIES AND OTHER ARTICLES OF COMMERCE SHALL BE SOLD AND DISPENSED TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC FROM MAY 15, 2005 TO JULY 15, 2005. SAID AREAS/STREETS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- A) BURGOS STREET (FROM COR. BONIFACIO ST. TO COR. J. NAVARRO ST. ONLY)
- B) MINI-FOREST (INFRONT - PARKING AREA)
- C) REAL STREET (FROM COR. EBONY TO BURGOS STS. - ONE LANE ONLY)
- D) ROAD BACK OF CITY HALL (WHOLE LANE)
- E) AREA AT THE SIDE OF THE CITY AGRIC. SERVICES & JUSTICE BLDG.
- F) SIDE OF CITY MAYOR'S OFFICE/EXECUTIVE BLDG. (I. LARRAZABAL BLVD.)
- G) SKATING RINK

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Tenth Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, That:

SECTION 1. The above-enumerated areas/streets of this city shall be temporarily closed for the establishment of a shopping area where goods, merchandise, foodstuff, commodities and other articles of commerce shall be sold and dispensed to the general public, from May 15, 2005 to July 15, 2005.

Also, the following streets of this city shall likewise be temporarily closed for the same duration from 3:00 PM to 4:00 the following day for the different activities that will be held at the said area, these are:

- a) Don Iñaki Larrazabal Blvd. (San Pedro to Bonifacio Sts.)
- b) J. Navarro Street (Cor. Burgos St. to the Seawall area)
- c) Maca-asim Street (Cor. Molave to the Seawall area)

SECTION 2. Prohibition. No person shall erect or place any stall, or any other structure use for vending any kind of commodity, outside the area specified by Section 1 hereof. A violation of this section shall be a ground for automatic revocation of the vendor's permit to sell within the closed area.


SECTION 3. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.

ENACTED, May 19, 2005.


RESOLVED, FINALLY, to furnish copies of this Ordinance, one each to His Honor, the City Mayor; the City Administrator, the City Legal Officer, the City Engineer, the City Planning & Development Officer, the Ormoc City Police Director, the Traffic Chief, Traffic Management Office, Ormoc PNP, and sufficient copies thereof be posted on Bulletin Boards at conspicuous places, -all in Ormoc City;
