## PREFATORY STATEMENT

The current Internal Rules and Procedures of this Sanggunian, particularly Rule 1(, section I, second par. of par (m) reads:

"The temporary presiding officer may vote on any motion or question as a regular member, but he may not take part in the floor deliberation while presiding,"

The aforequoted provision is not in accord with the ruling of the Supreme Court in the case of ZAMORA v. CABALLERO ET AL., (G.R. NO. 147767, January 14, 2004), when it ruled that while acting as presiding officer, Soard Member Osorio may not, at the same time, be allowed to exercise the rights of a regular board member including that of voting when there is no tie to break. A temporary presiding officer who merely steps into the shoes of the presiding officer could not have greater power than that possessed by the latter who can vote only in power than that possessed by the latter who can vote only in case of tie."

In view of the aforequoted ruling of the Supreme Court, the provision of our Internal Rules and Procedures, specifically Rule II, section I, second par. of par. (m) should be amended to conform with the aforementioned ruling of our Supreme Court.

# ORDINANCE NO. 127

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SECOND PAR., OF PAR (M) OF SEC. I OF RULE II OF THE RULES AND PROCEDURES OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD NG ORMOC.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TENTH SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD NG ORMOC, That:

SECTION 1. The second paragraph of paragraph (m) of Section I, Rule II of the Rules and Procedures of the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, is hereby amended by changing the whole wordings thereof, and now to read as follows:

"The temporary presiding officer is vested with the same powers as that of the regular presiding officer, hence he can only vote to break a tie, and may not take part in the floor deliberations while presiding.".RM72

SECTION 2. This amendatory ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval; ENACTED, March 2, 2006.
