## EXPLANATORY NOTE

under the Rules Government Units are empowered, Regulations Implementing the Local Government Code of 1991, particularly rule VIII, Article 42 thereof, to temporarily or permanently close or open any road, alley, park or square within its jurisdiction through an ordinance.

45 Article 10 the said Implementing Rules and Regulations the instances whereby a Local Government Unit may close any enumerates national or local roads, alley, park or square, the duration of which shall be determined by the Local Chief Executive concerned in a written order, letter (b) of said article provides;

"Art. 45. Temporary Closure -

> XX x x x

> > (b) An LGU may temporarily close and regulate the use of any street, road, thoroughfare, or public place where shopping malls, Sunday markets, flea or night markets, or shopping areas may be established and where goods, merchandise, foodstuff, commodities, or articles commerce may be sold and dispensed to the general public".

Relative thereto, the Office of the City Mayor through 1st Indorsement dated May 21, 2007 has forwarded to the 10th Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc the request of the Ormoc City Fiesta Committee 2007 for temporary closure of the road at the back of the City Hall, Macaasin St., and the road fronting the City Stage;

The said temporary road closure shall be strictly imposed only in the above mentioned roads during the period specified;

FOREGOING, PREMISES CONSIDERED, on motion of City Councilor Jose C. Alfaro, Jr., Chairman, Committee on Public Properties, joinly seconded by City Councilors Manuel T. Fiel and Ruben R. Capahi; be it

## ORDINANCE NO. 133

AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY CLOSING THE ROAD AT THE BACK OF THE CITY HALL, MACAASIN ST., AND THE ROAD FRONTING THE CITY STAGE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY UP TO JULY 15, 2007.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Tenth Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, That:

SECTION 1. The road at the back of the City Hall, Macaasin St., and the road fronting the City Stage shall be temporarily closed effective immediately until July 15, 2007.

SECTION 2. The road fronting the City Stage including the roads at both sides of the said stage shall be closed effective immediately only from 6:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m. of the following day everyday during the duration above specified.

SECTION 3. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.

ENACTED, May 31, 2007.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, to furnish copies of this ordinance, one each to His Honor, the City Mayor, the City Administrator, the City Legal Officer, the City Engineer, the City Planning & Development Coordinator, the Ormoc City Police Director, the Ormoc City Traffic Management Office, and sufficient copies thereof be posted on the Bulletin Boards at conspicuous places, -all in Ormoc City.
