WHEREAS, the information highway created as a result of the development in electronic technology provided our people better opportunities for advancement in the social, political, technological and economic endeavors;

WHEREAS, setting up an accessible and sustainable internet-based resource center would provide the city constituency especially the less fortunate students/citizens the utmost use of information and communications technology;

WHEREAS, the establishment of an e-learning and research center (eLRC) resulting from a partnership initiative between the Hon. City Mayor Eric C. Codilla and Mr. Manuel Baylon Jr., a Filipino US Citizen now residing in Arizona, USA who donated fifty (50) units of brand new computers is a most welcomed development;

WHEREAS, the establishment of an e-learning and research center (eLRC) that will principally serve the educational development needs of the disadvantaged and underserved members of our community is an equalizing move that will provide them access to information which are otherwise available only to the elite group;

WHEREAS, the donor who donated the fifty (50) units of brand new computer sets along with printers and switches would like to be assured of the following:

- a) That the donated equipments be kept always in the center and be managed by the CPDO-IT department;
- b) That the center shall continue to operate even if there is a change in the leadership of the city;

RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 136

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ORMOC CITY COMMUNITY E-LEARNING AND RESEARCH CENTER (CeLRC) AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES RELEVANT THERETO.

BE IT ENACTED, by the Eleventh Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, That:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the "ORMOC CITY COMMUNITY E-LEARNING AND RESEARCH CENTER (CeLRC) ORDINANCE".

SECTION 2. THE NAME. There shall be established in the City of Ormoc a center to be known as the "ORMOC CITY COMMUNITY E-LEARNING AND RESEARCH CENTER (CeLRC)" which shall undertake the following objectives and functions:

- 2.1 Bring Information and Communications Technology initiatives to the unserved or underserved members of the community;
- 2.2 Provide access to information;
- 2.3 The LGU commits to promote the use of ICT for effective and efficient governance and to provide:
 - 2.3.1 Constituents access online transaction like payment of business taxes and licenses, billing, birth certificate, etc.;
 - 2.3.2 Constituents to inquire information about the City (like population, income, etc.);
 - 2.3.3 Constituents to link information with other government offices and other agencies;
 - 2.3.4 Constitutents to update knowledge on the newly imposed city ordinances.
- 2.4 Provide the less fortunate students the facilities for doing research which are normally available only in private internet cafes;

SECTION 3. THE LOCATION OF THE CENTER. The Ormoc City E-learning and Research Center shall be established in the 2nd floor of the Public Market Building A or in any other location/place the Board may decide. The center shall have adequate space for the 50 units of computer sets along with the corresponding printers and switches and other equipments that maybe added or donated to the E-learning Center.

center shall be lodged in a BOARD OF TRUSTEES composed of the following:

Chairman - City Mayor
Vice Chairman - Chairman Committee on Education (SP)
Members - CPDO Officer
IT Chief
GSD Officer
City Treasurer
City Accountant
City Budget Officer
Market Superintendent

SECTION 5. POWERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES. The Board of Trustees being the policy making body of the center shall;

- 5.1 Administer, control and supervise the activities provided for in section 2 hereof;
- 5.2 The board designates a center manager;
- 5.3 Formulate the Operations Manual (OM) and prescribe rules and regulations to carry out the purposes for which the center is established;
- 5.4 Receive donations of all kinds for the enhancement and sustainability of the center;
- 5.5 Procure and administer its funds and disbursements of the same;
- 5.6 Procure such other things necessary to equip the center so as to efficiently and effectively accomplish its objectives and purposes;
- 5.7 Prepare and submit the annual budget for inclusion in the regular annual budget of the city.

SECTION 6. HONORARIA FOR THE CENTER MANAGER AND PART-TIME INSTRUCTOR/S. The Board of Trustees (BOT) shall include in their annual budget provision for the honoraria of the center manager and part-time instructor/s, if any, in accordance with the provisions of the Civil Service Laws, Rules and Regulations.

SECTION 7. Schedule of Board Meetings. The board shall conduct a regular meeting once a month. Emergency meetings may be called twice a month.

SECTION 8. FUNDING. The operation and maintenance of the center shall be funded from such sources as:

- 7.1 Separate appropriation item in the regular annual city budget. Appropriation shall be based on estimated operation expenditure to be submitted by the Board of Trustees (BOT).
- 7.2 Donations, grants in aid, and such other monies obtained from various sources by the center from private agencies.

SECTION 9. AUTOMATIC INTEGRATION. Any and all existing and incoming E-learning and Research Center (eLRC) shall be integrated into and/or vested in the herein created, "ORMOC CITY COMMUNITY E-LEARNING AND RESEARCH CENTER (CeLRC)".


SECTION 10. REPEAL. Any other ordinances or sections thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and modified accordingly.
