#### PREFATORY STATEMENT

WHEREAS Ormos City, an independent component City, concerned with its desire to improve the standard of living and quality of life of every ORMOCANON, must improve on its productivity that will be competitive in the local, regional, national and even in the international market.

WHEREAS, one of the strategies in the attainment of our goals is for Ormoc City to invest and embark on Programs and Projects on HEALTH, a basic human need.

WHEREAS, for the improvement of the health status of the community, our main focus would rivet on our health service delivery system that aims to be accessible, available, compatible, relevant, efficient, effective, viable, sustainable and above all affordable; a health service delivery system that would touch each and every household and its family members marketing health as its product for a healthy community.

WHEREAS, consistent with this vision, the City thru Executive Order No. 2007-12 decentralized the Ormoc City Health Department into six (6) District Health Centers to bring health services closer to the consumers of health.

WHEREAS, other City Health initiatives were, the enactment of the Maternity and Newborn Care Ordinance of 2010, for Pregnant Mothers and Newborns to receive safe pregnancy, safe delivery and postpartum services from our health professionals in our District Health Centers (DHC); and the accreditation of our DHC's as birthing facilities by PHILHEALTH.

WHEREAS, the indigent members of our community are considered vital and important constituents who deserve to receive adequate and affordable medical services from existing health facilities.

WHEREAS, in spite of the vigorous implementation of the current health measures, there are still gaps and lapses that were identified in the health care delivery system more particularly in the over-congestion of our existing referral facility for which the immediate and responsive augmentation of the existing health facilities is imperative.

WHEREAS, the application for a Permit to Construct (PTC) a hospital by Ormoc City was approved by the Department of Health, Bureau of Health Facilities and Services, Manila, on January 31, 2012 under PTC No. 12-078.

WHEREAS, harmonizing public health and hospital services are necessary and imperative especially that this is mandated in Section 17 Paragraph 3 and Paragraph H in conjunction with Paragraph 4 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

WHEREFORE FOREGOING PREMISES CONSIDERED, on metion of City Councilor Rafael C. Omega, Jr., Chairman, Committee on Health, duly seconded by City Councilor Sotero M. Pepito; be it.

RESOLVED, to enact:

#### ORDINANCE NO. 179

#### AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ORMOC CIY HOSPITAL

BE IT ORDAINED by The TWELFTH Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, That:

#### ARTICLE I TITLE OF THE ORDINANCE

SECTION 1. TYLE OF THE ORDINANCE – This ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Establishing the Ormoc City Hospital".

SECTION 2 SCOPE This ordinance shall govern the establishment and operation of the Ormoc City Hospital at Brgy, San Pablo, Ormoc City.

#### ARTICLE II DEFINITION OF TERMS / ABBREVIATIONS / ACRONYMS

HEALTH - The state of complete physical, social and mental well-being, not merely the absence of disease or infirmity (WHO)

HOSPITAL - A complex health facility with a dynamic organization within the health system interacting with various factors and with the environment

MEDICAL - Practice of Medicine

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#### ARTICLE III AUTHORITY

#### SECTION 3. AUTHORITY - This ordinance is enacted pursuant to:

- 3.1. Section 16 of the LGC, which provides that "Every Local Government Unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare," which includes, among others, to promote the health and safety of their inhabitants.
- 3.2 Section 17 (4) (e) of the same code, which provides that "National agencies or offices shall devolve to local government units the responsibility for the provision of basic health services and facilities x x x". Section 17 (4) (j) second paragraph further provides that costs may also be charged for the delivery of basic health services or facilities enumerated in this section.
- 3.3. Section (2) (g) of Executive Order No. 503, Series of 1992 (The rules and regulations implementing the devolution of functions of the National government agencies to local government units), which provides that the Local Chief Executive shall be responsible for all such devolved functions.
- 3.4. Section 18 of the LGC, which provides that "Local Government Units shall have the power and authority to establish an organization that shall be responsible for the efficient and effective implementation of their development plans, program objectives and priorities; to create their own sources of revenue and to levy taxes, fees, and charges which shall accrue exclusively for their use and disposition x x x".

## ARTICLE IV THE ORMOC CITY HOSPITAL

SECTION 4. THE ORMOC CITY HOSPITAL – There is hereby established the Ormoc City Hospital (OCH) with an initial bed capacity of twenty-five (25) beds and of a Level II Service Capability with Operating Room based on the DOH Standard of Classification of Hospitals, as specified in the PTC, to cater primarily to Maternal and Child Clients.

#### 4.1 Purposes:

- To provide the necessary hospital services especially to the indigent and marginalized members of the community.
- (ii) To create the necessary facilities for the purpose of providing health care services to the community.
- (iii) To serve as the referral hospital of the DHCs in the City of Ormoc.
- (iv) To be concerned not only with the hospital needs of the ommunity but also as a tool for health promotion and disease prevention.
- (v) To provide ancillary health services such as laboratory, radiology, dental and other related services that are accessible, sustainable, and affordable services.
- 4.2 Governing Board The OCH shall be governed by the Board of Trustees which shall carry out the purposes enumerated above and administer the operations of the hospital in accordance with the generally accepted standards set by the DOH and by pertinent regulatory agencies and shall ensure the efficient, effective, and professional operations of the hospital.

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- (i) The Board of Trustees shall be composed of the following:
  - (a) City Mayor Chairman
  - (b) SP, Chairman, Committee on Health Vice-Chairman
  - (c) Chief of Hospital II Member
  - (d) City Health Officer II Member
  - (e) City Administrator Member
  - (f) City Treasurer Member
  - (g) President, OCMS Member
- (iii) The members of the Board of Trustee who are government officials or employees shall perform their duties as such without compensation or remuneration. Members thereof, who are not government officials or employees, shall be entitled to receive honoraria in accordance with Department of Budget and Management, Circular No. 62, series of 1996.
- 4.3 Head of Hospital The OCH shall be headed by a Chief of Hospital II, SG-25, to be appointed by the LCE subject to Civil Service Laws, Rules and Regulations, and with the concurrence of the majority of all the members of the Sanggunian Panlungsod. The Term of Office of the COH II shall be co-terminous with the Appointing Authority.
- 4.4 Organizational Structure and Staffing Pattern The Initial Organizational Structure and Staffing Pattern for the OCH, in accordance with DOM Standards, is hereby decreed and established with the creation of sixty three (63) regular positions as enumerated and described in Annex "A" of this Ordinance.
- 4.5. Major Hospital Services -The major hospital services shall be as follows:
  - (i) Medical Services
  - (ii) Narsing Services
  - (iii) Administrative Services
- 4.6 Personnel Qualification Standards—The Qualification Standards of the positions in the OCH shall be in accordance with the pertinent qualification standards, regulations, and other related issuances of the Civil Service Commission, the Department of Health, and as may be determined by the Board of Trustees. (Annex "B")

SECTION 5 <u>APPROPRIATION AND FUNDING SOURCE</u> - The summary of appropriations for the initial operation of the OCH shall be as follows:

5.4. FUNDING SOURCE - The initial appropriation needed for the mplementation of this Ordinance shall be taken from the unappropriated surplus end of year 2012 of the General Fund. Subsequent funding requirements shall be included in the Annual Budget of the City Government.

#### ARTICLE VI FINAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If any part, section or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional, other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE – All local ordinances, executive orders, issuances, rules and regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after it has been posted in the Bulletin Board of the City Hall, and two (2) other conspicuous places in the City of Ormoc, and published once in a local newspaper of general circulation.
