PREFATORY STATEMENT

WHEREAS, an endorsement was issued by the City Mayor dated December 13, 2017 requesting the Sanggunians Panlungsod to enact an amendatory ordinance lifting the citor coding and zoning restriction of motorized tricycles during peak hours.

WHEREAS, it has been observed that during peak hours, between five o'clock in the afternoon to nine o'clock in the evening, there is an influx of passengers causing a long queue in our temporary terminals, and consequently an inconvenience to our riding public.

WHEREAS, because of the color coding scheme and zoning restrictions, other motorized tricycles that are available could not service the demand of other zones or routes.

whereas, lifting the color coding scheme and zoning restrictions during peak hours would allow all motorized vehicles to ply any zone, and serve those routes with high demand.

RESOLVED, enact:

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ORDINANCE NO. 055

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 153 SERIES OF 2009 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS AN ORDINANCE RATIONALIZING THE OPERATION OF MOTORIZED TRICYCLES FOR HIRE IN ORMOC CITY BY ADOPTING ZONES AND COLOR - CODING SCHEMES IN THE OPERATION THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED, by the Fourteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, that:

SECTION 1. The Section 4 of Ordinance No. 153 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 4. The City of Ormoc, for purposes of the operation of motorized tricycle for hire, shall be divided into four (4) major zones with the designation of the color to be used thereat, to wit:

ZONE 1. (FREE ZONE) – Shall cover the areas of: Barangay District Nos. 1 to 29:

Barangays:

Don F. Larrazabal San Isidro
Alegria Bagong Buhay

Batuan Libertad, up to crossing Airport only

Punta

Linao Salvacion, up to crossing Dayhagan only Naungan San Pablo, up to San Pablo Rotonda only

Tambulilid Sto. Niño

Doña Feliza Mejia Bantigue up to Panilahan Bridge

Cogon Alta Vista
Can-agieng Nasunogan

Camp Downes

The designated color - code for this area is RED. ZONE 2 - Shall cover the areas of Barangays:

Tpil Can-untog
San Arcenio Danhug
Macabug Mabini

The designated color-code for this area is BLUE. ZONE 3 - Shall cover the areas of Barangays:

Dolores Concepcion
Milagro Hibunaon
Luna San Jose
Dayhagan Maticaa
Valencia Sabang Bao
Cagbuhangin Cabulihan

Juaton

The designated color – code for this area is GOLD. ZONE 4 - Shall cover the areas of Barangays:

Lilo-an San Juan
Lao Margen
Licuma Labrador
Curva R.M. Tan
Mas-in San Vicente

Japan Japan

The designated color – code for this area is GREEN.

The designated color scheme and corresponding zoning restrictions shall be lifted between five o'clock in the afternoon to five o'clock in the morning each day.

SECTION 2. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, rules and regulations, or parts herein in conflict with or are inconsistent to the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.

SECTION 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Any portion or provision of this Ordinance that may be declared ultra vires or invalid shall not nullify the rest of the provisions hereof.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and after compliance with the requirements of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.
