EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 041, series of 2020, otherwise known as an Ordinance Establishing the Ormoc City Museum, Providing for its Organizational Structure, Defining its Powers, Duties and Functions, and for Other Purposes", was signed into law last September 29, 2020;

WHEREAS, the Human Resource Management Office raised a concern that in the aforesaid Ordinance, the proposed position "Project Development Officer III" is rather general and belongs to an Occupational Service and the function of which is less intimate to tourism. As such, it is prudent to align proposed position/s to the Index of Occupational Service (IOS) more specific to the function of tourism and in consonance with CSC Memorandum Circular No. 04, s 2018, "QS for the Tourism Operations Positions in the Local Government Units Pursuant to R.A. No. 9593";

WHEREAS, based on the Index of Occupational Services (IOS) that contains the list of classes or position titles existing in the government grouped by occupation, the "Project Development Officer III" belongs to *Planning Services* concerned with the formulation, implementation and evaluation of development plans, programs and projects. The head of the museum on the other hand which takes charge of the entire operations of the City Museum falls under the Tourism enterprises where the proposed position fits more consistently. The *Tourism Industry Services* where the 'Senior Tourism Operations Officer' belongs, is concerned with developing, promoting and regulating trade, tourism, cooperatives and other commercial and industrial activities, consistent with RA 9593 otherwise known as "The Tourism Act of 2009";

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 004, also known as the "Ormoc City Tourism Policy and Program Ordinance of 2016", the highest position created is the 'Supervising Tourism Operations Officer' with Salary Grade 22 while the proposed 'Senior Tourism Operations Officer' has Salary Grade 18. It is lower than the existing City Tourism Officer and therefore has no conflict;

WHEREAS, Section 76 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that "every local government unit shall design and implement its own organizational structure and staffing pattern taking into consideration its service requirements and financial capability, subject to the minimum standards and guidelines prescribed by the Civil Service Commission";

WHEREAS, to address said concern and be in line with above mandates, the position name shall be changed;

NOW, THEREFORE, on joint motion of SP Member Jasper M. Lucero, Chairman, Committee on Good Government and Oversight, and SP Member Peter M. Rodriguez, Chairman, Committee on Tourism, Culture and Arts, severally seconded by SP Members Tomas R. Serafica, Joan Marbie C. Simbajon, Esteban V. Laurente, Eusebio Gerardo S. Penserga, Lalaine A. Marcos and Roiland H. Villasencio; be it

RESOLVED, to enact:

ORDINANCE NO. 048 (Series of 2020)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 10, 11 AND 13 OF ORDINANCE NO. 041, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ORMOC CITY MUSEUM, PROVIDING FOR ITS ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE, DEFINING ITS POWERS, DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES".

BE IT ORDAINED by the 15th Sangguniang Panlungsod of Ormoc City, that:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS- the following sections of Ordinance No. 041 are hereby amended to read as follows:

- A. <u>SECTION 10.</u> <u>COMPOSITION AND STRUCTURE</u> The Ormoc City Museum shall be organized as a section of the Ormoc City Tourism Office and shall be composed initially of a *Senior Tourism Operations Officer* who will act as curator, to be assisted by three (3) staffs, each responsible for the registry and archive, education and exhibit, and the physical structure of the City Museum, their position titles, salary grades, duties and functions are more particularly described below:
 - (1) Senior Tourism Operations Officer Salary Grade 18

B. <u>SECTION 11. CREATION OF NEW POSITIONS</u>— There is hereby created three (3) new positions under the Ormoc City Museum and the corresponding Salary Grade are as follows:

- C. SECTION 13. QUALIFICATIONS OF SENIOR TOURISM OPERATIONS OFFICER, MUSEUM RESEARCHER II AND MUSEUM RESEARCHER I— The Senior Tourism Operations Officer (SG 18), Museum Researcher II (SG 14) and Museum Researcher I (SG 10) positions shall have the following qualifications, respectively:
 - a. Qualifications of Senior Tourism Operations Officer (SG 18):

Qualifications	Requirement
Education	Bachelor's Degree in tourism, business, law, economics, marketing, public administration, or other related fields
Experience	2 years of work experience and involvement in the tourism industry either in the private sector or the government
Training	 8 hours relevant training on tourism or DOT specific and mandatory trainings such as but not limited to the following: Tourism Awareness and Capability Building Seminar for LGUs Seminar on Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Basic Tourism Statistics Training (BTST) Local Tourism Guidebook Orientation and; Seminar on Gender and Development Orientation
Eligibility	Career Service (Professional/ 2nd Level Eligibility)

SECTION 2. REPEALING CLAUSE— All Ordinances and or Resolutions, or portions thereof, inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE— If for any reason any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid by any competent court, the other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY– This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and after compliance with necessary posting and publication requirements of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.
