RESOLUTION NO. 2019-012

A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ THE AUTHORITY TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC (LGU-ORMOC) WITH THE PHILIPPINE COUNCIL FOR AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES (PCAF), FOR THE DOWNLOADING OF OPERATIONAL FUNDS FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2019 IN THE AMOUNT OF FORTY-EIGNT THOUSAND PHILIPPINE PESOS (PMP48,000.00).

WHEREAS, the 14TH Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc received an endorsement letter from the Office of the City Mayor on January 09, 2019 for consideration of a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to be entered into by the Local Government Unit of Ormoc (LGU-ORMOC) and the Philippine Council for Agriculture and Fisheries (PCAF), represented by its Executive Director, SARAH GUTIERREZ-CAYONA;

WHEREAS, the PCAF under Executive Order No. 366, Series of 2004 assumes strengthened functions related to coordination and monitoring of agriculture and fisheries modernization processes, and development of public-private partnerships as consultative bodies to the Department of Agriculture (DA);

WHEREAS, for the development of public and private partnerships, PCAF shall provide technical leadership, guidance and support for the continued development of the nationwide network of Agricultural and Fishery Councils (AFCs) and the National Sectoral Strategic Concerns Committees (NSSCCs);

WHEREAS, the PCAF shall provide technical and financial support for the AFCs in consultation, integration and networking activities in the City of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, the LGU-ORMOC shall oversee the implementation of the various programs/projects/ activities of the AFCs and NSSCCs and shall provide technical assistance to ensure the attainment of its thrusts and mandates;

WHEREAS, CY 2019 PCAF budget provides funds for AFC operations and PCAF is authorized to release said funds to the AFCs as donations and representation expense through the Department of Agriculture-Regional Field Offices and other authorized conduits;

WHEREAS, PCAF shall allocate, obligate and release to the City Agriculture Office (CAO) this City, the amount of FORTY-EIGHT THOUSAND PHILIPPINE PESOS (Php48,000.00) as CY 2019 operational funds for the AFC operations and consultations;

WHEREAS, after review of the draft MOA by the City Legal Officer of the City, he finds nothing legally objectionable therein considering that the same is in order, not contrary to law, morals or public policy and not detrimental to the best interest of the City, recommending that the aforementioned MOA be endorsed to this august Body for the issuance of a Resolution granting the City Mayor the authority to enter into agreement in behalf of LGU-ORMOC pursuant to Section 22(c) in relation to Section 455(b)(vi) of R.A. No. 7160 (Local Government Code);

WHEREAS, upon close and thorough review, this Sanggunian finds that the aforementioned MOA is advantageous and for the best interest of the City, especially the farmers, fisherfolks and to the community as a whole;

NOW THEREFORE, on joint motion of SP Member Tomas R. Serafica, Chairman of the Committee on Agriculture, Fisheries, and Agrarian Reform and SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos Jr., Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, severally seconded by SP Members Vincent L. Rama, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, Eusebio Gerardo S. Penserga, Nolito M. Quilang, John Eulalio Nepomuceno O. Aparis II, Esteban V. Laurente and Jasper C. Yerro; be it

RESOLVED as it is hereby to pass a RESOLUTION GRANTING THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ THE AUTHORITY TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC (LGU-ORMOC) WITH THE PHILIPPINE COUNCIL FOR AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES (PCAF), FOR THE DOWNLOADING OF OPERATIONAL FUNDS FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2019 IN THE AMOUNT OF FORTY-EIGHT THOUSAND PHILIPPINE PESOS (PHP 48,000.00);

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR AGRICULTURAL AND FISHERY COUNCILS (AFCs)

KNOWN ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENT:

This Memorandum of Agreement entered into by and between:

The PHILIPPINE COUNCIL FOR AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES (PCAF), a government agency attached to the Department of Agriculture (DA) pursuant to Executive Order No. 366, Series of 2004 and approved Rationalization Plan dated June 26, 2013, with office address at the Apacible Hall, DA Compound, Elliptical Road, Diliman, Quezon City, represented in this Act by its Executive Director, SARAH GUTIERREZ-CAYONA, hereinafter referred to as the FIRST PARTY;

and

The LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT (LGU) ORMOC CITY, with office address at New City Hall, Brgy. Cogon, Ormoc City, represented in this Act by the CITY MAYOR, RICHARD I. GOMEZ, hereinafter referred to as the SECOND PARTY;

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the FIRST PARTY under Executive Order No. 366, Series of 2004 assumes strengthened functions related to coordination and monitoring of agriculture and fisheries modernization processes, and development of public private partnerships as consultative bodies to the Department of Agriculture (DA);

WHEREAS, for the development of public and private partnerships, the FIRST PARTY shall provide technical leadership, guidance and support for the continued development of the nationwide network of Agricultural and Fishery Councils (AFCs) and the National Sectoral Strategic Concerns Committees (NSSCCs);

WHEREAS, for the AVCs, the MAST PARTY shall provide technical and financial support in the consultation, integration and networking activities in **Ormoc City**;

WHEREAS, the SECONN PARTY oversees the implementation of the various programs/projects/activities in the province and provides technical assistance to ensure the attainment of its thrusts and mandates including that of the FIRST PARTY on consultation integration networking and advocacy in the local communities;

WHEREAS, the CY 2019 agency budget provides funds for AFC operations and PCAF is authorized to release said funds to the AFCs as donations through the DA-RFOs and other authorized conduits.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing covenants and stipulations, the parties hereby agree as follows:

I. The FIRST PARTY shall:

a. Allot, obligate and release to C A O the amount of **FORTY-EIGHT THOUSAND PESOS** (P48,000.00) as **CY 2019 operational funds** for the AFC **consultations** and record to Account Code "Donations" following the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations;

b. Reserve the right to intervene and institute measures in case of, but not limited to misuse of the fund and non-compliance with the provisions stipulated in this agreement; and

 Periodically monitor the utilization of fund releases and the submission of physical and financial AFC accomplishment report.

II. The SECOND PARTY shall:

- a. Issue official receipt/s to the FIRST PARTY for the fund received;
- Disburse the fund based on the attached AFC work and financial plan (Annex
 A) and maintain a separate financial record in accordance with the Philippine
 Public Sector Accounting Standards;
- Submit physical accomplishment reports based on the schedules provided in Annex B and other relevant reports as requested by the FIRST PARTY;
- d. Submit expenditure/liquidation report (Annex C) duly verified by the resident auditor; and
- e. Refund to the FIRST PARTY any unused fund ending December 31, 2019.
- III. In the event the **SECOND PARTY** fails to submit the required physical and disbursement reports of previous release for AFC operational expenses, subsequent release of the same purpose shall be held by the **FIRST PARTY** pending the submission of the required reports
