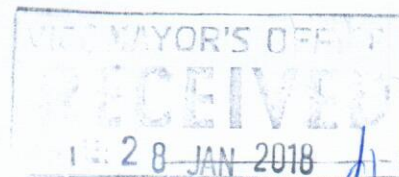

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-021

**AN OMNIBUS RESOLUTION RENAMING THE FOLLOWING
SCHOOLS OF ORMOC CITY, TO WIT:**

- 1) SAN JOSE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO SAN JOSE
CENTRAL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL LOCATED IN
BARANGAY SAN JOSE, ORMOC CITY;**
- 2) DOLORES ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO DOLORES
CENTRAL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL LOCATED IN
BARANGAY DOLORES, ORMOC CITY;**
- 3) CURVA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO CURVA CENTRAL
ELEMENTARY SCHOOL LOCATED IN BARANGAY
CURVA, ORMOC CITY;**
- 4) SAN ISIDRO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO SAN ISIDRO
CENTRAL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, LOCATED IN
BARANGAY SAN ISIDRO, ORMOC CITY, AND**
- 5) AIRPORT PRIMARY SCHOOL TO AIRPORT
ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, LOCATED IN BARANGAY
AIRPORT, ORMOC CITY.**

WHEREAS, this august Body was in receipt of an Indorsement from the Office of the City Mayor dated September 7, 2018, endorsing the request of Dr. Manuel P. Albaño, Schools Division Superintendent of DepEd Ormoc City Division, requesting for the passage of the necessary Ordinance or Resolution in relation to the changing of the names of the following schools; San Jose Elementary School, Dolores Elementary School, Curva Elementary School, San Isidro Elementary School,

Airport Primary School, and San Pablo Elementary School into San Jose Central Elementary School, Dolores Central Elementary School, Curva Central Elementary School, San Isidro Central Elementary School, Airport Elementary School, and Concepcion P. Tan Elementary School, a copy of the said letter is hereto attached and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, due to the growing population of elementary students, DepEd Ormoc City Division has been granted by the DepEd Region Office 8 to reorganize its existing composition from six districts into 10 districts under DepEd Regional Memorandum No. 308 s. 2018, hence the renaming of the four aforementioned elementary schools to complete the ten districts;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section VI.A.5 of DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2014, the Local Sanggunian, under Section 99 (d) of the Local Government Code of 1991 is authorized to change the name of schools upon the recommendation of the Local School Board;

WHEREAS, Section 13 (b) of the Local Government Code of 1991 also provided that independent component cities may, in consultation with the Philippine Historical Commission, change the name of the following within its territorial jurisdiction: x x x x (3) Public elementary, secondary, and vocational or technical schools, community colleges and non-chartered colleges x x x;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the mandate under the Local Government Code that cities need to consult Philippine Historical Commission in changing names of schools, the Sanggunian Committee on Education and Manpower Development agreed in a Committee Meeting to send a communication to the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP) to seek guidance on the processes of changing names of school and the role of the NHCP in the process of renaming;

WHEREAS, in a reply letter dated November 13, 2018, Acting Executive Director Ludovico D. Badoy of the NHCP provided the Revised Guidelines on the Naming/Renaming of Public Structures and asked the Sanggunian to submit to NHCP copies of the resolutions from the Local School Board and from the Sangguniang Panlungsod;

WHEREAS, on October 3, 2018 through Resolution No. 2018 - 18, the Local School Board (LSB) of Ormoc City found the request of DepEd Ormoc City Division with merit and requested the 14th Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc to rename aforementioned schools, a copy of the said LSB Resolution is hereto attached and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, in a Committee Meeting on Oct. 17, 2018, the Committee on Education and Manpower Development finds merit in the request to rename San Jose Elementary School, Dolores Elementary School, Curva Elementary School, San Isidro Elementary School, and Airport Primary School but not yet for San Pablo Elementary School that requires additional documentary requirements such as the deed of donation;

WHEREAS, upon close and thorough review, this Sanggunian finds that the request to change the names of the aforementioned schools is not contrary to law, public policy, and public morals and most deserving of this august Body's full support and affirmative action;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Nolito M. Quilang, Chairman, Committee, on Education and Manpower Development, severally seconded by SP Members Vincent L. Rama, Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, Lea Doris C. Villar, Esteban V. Laurente and Jasper C. Yerro; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY, RESOLVED, to pass AN OMNIBUS RESOLUTION RENAMING THE FOLLOWING SCHOOLS OF ORMOC CITY, TO WIT:


- 1) SAN JOSE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO SAN JOSE CENTRAL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL LOCATED IN BARANGAY SAN JOSE, ORMOC CITY;
- 2) DOLORES ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO DOLORES CENTRAL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL LOCATED IN BARANGAY DOLORES, ORMOC CITY;
- 3) CURVA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO CURVA CENTRAL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL LOCATED IN BARANGAY CURVA, ORMOC CITY;
- 4) SAN ISIDRO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO SAN ISIDRO CENTRAL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, LOCATED IN BARANGAY SAN ISIDRO, ORMOC CITY; AND
- 5) AIRPORT PRIMARY SCHOOL TO AIRPORT ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, LOCATED IN BARANGAY AIRPORT, ORMOC CITY.

Dear Hon. Gomez:

DepEd Regional Memorandum No. 308 s. 2018 entitled "Reorganization of 6 Existing Schools Districts into 10 Schools Districts in Ormoc City Division" has granted Ormoc City Division to re-organize its existing composition into 10 districts.

Six districts have existing central schools as part of the composition of the previous 6-redistricting. Considering the need to have a central school per district, the division needs to name additional four (4) central schools to complete the 10 districts to have their own central school.

Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2014, Section VI.A.5 stating "Section 99 (d) of Republic Act No. 7160 (Local Government Code of 1991) authorizes the Local Sanggunian to change the name of schools through an ordinance with the Local School Board as the recommending body". In connection to this, DepEd Ormoc City Division is humbly requesting the City Council for the renaming of the following schools through a City Ordinance as stated above. The schools are listed below with their corresponding new names:

Name of School	Proposed Name of School
1. San Jose Elementary School	San Jose Central Elementary School
2. Dolores Elementary School	Dolores Central Elementary School
3. Curva Elementary School	Curva Central Elementary School
4. San Isidro Elementary School	San Isidro Central Elementary School

In addition, we would like to request to include the following schools in the same ordinance:

1. **Airport Primary School** to be renamed as **Airport Elementary School** since this school is no longer a primary school and is now offering complete elementary education.
2. **San Pablo Elementary School** to be renamed as **Concepcion P. Tan Elementary School**, per lot donors' request.

WHEREAS, in a meeting of the Local School Board, School Division Superintendent (SDS) Dr. Manuel P. Albaño explained that DEPED Ormoc City Division reorganized the schools' districts from original four to 10 districts;

WHEREAS, the clustering of the schools into 10 districts resulted to the following schools identified as central schools:






