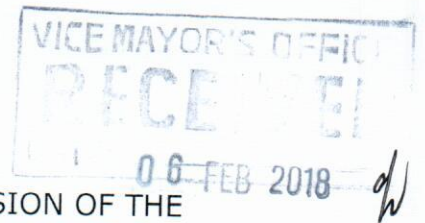
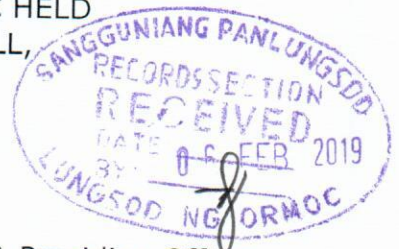

**A RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY
MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ OR THE ACTING CITY
MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN A MEMORANDUM
OF AGREEMENT (MOA), FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE
LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC (LGU-ORMOC),
WITH THE OCCIDENTAL LEYTE BAR ASSOCIATION
(OLBA) RELATIVE TO THE CONDUCT OF A TRAINING
SEMINAR AND WORKSHOP FOR ALL BARANGAY
OFFICIALS IN THE PREPARATION AND PASSAGE OF
BARANGAY ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS,
AMONG OTHERS.**

WHEREAS, this Fourteenth Sangguniang Panlungsod was in receipt of an Indorsement dated January 30, 2019 from the Office of the City Mayor, relative to the MOA to be entered into by the Local Government Unit of Ormoc (LGU-Ormoc) with the Occidental Leyte Bar Association (OLBA) requesting that the City Mayor or the Acting Mayor be granted authority to sign the said MOA, for and on behalf of LGU-Ormoc, relative to the conduct of a training seminar and workshop as to the enactment of Barangay Ordinances and Resolutions for the benefit of all Ormoc City Barangay Officials, a photocopy of the final MOA is hereto attached as Annex "A" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, in a letter dated January 30, 2019, Atty. Alexander G. Salas, Director of the Committee on the Administration of Justice of OLBA, proposed the holding of a Training Seminar and Workshop for the benefit of all Ormoc Barangay Officials wherein OLBA will provide competent speakers who will discuss the provisions of the Local Government Code along with pertinent laws as to the enactment of barangay ordinances and resolutions, a copy of said letter is hereto attached as Annex "B" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, OLBA is an aggrupation of lawyers residing and/or practicing and/or with roots in cities of Ormoc and Baybay and the municipalities of Albuera, Bato, Hilongos, Hindang, Inopacan, Isabel, Kananga, Matag-ob, Matalom, Merida, Palompon, San Isidro, Tabango and Villaba, all of Leyte, Philippines;

WHEREAS, OLBA, in the discharge of its public responsibility, aims to be the forefront in promoting and upholding the principles of justice and equity;

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the vital role of barangays in nation building, serving as the primary planning and implementing unit of government policies, plans, programs, projects and activities in the community;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 (LGC), specifically provides that the Sangguniang Barangay has the duty to enact ordinances and resolutions necessary to carry out the Sanggunian's responsibilities, promote the general welfare of the people, impose and collect taxes/revenues, and approve the barangay's annual and supplemental budgets;

WHEREAS, effective barangays can serve public interest, promote and preserve peace and order, and raise revenues for the barangays, which will in effect benefit the City;

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian finds this MOA in order, pursuant to the provisions of Section 455, Paragraph (b) (1) (vi) of Republic Act 7160 of the LGC, which authorizes the City Mayor to represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod concerned pursuant to law or ordinance;

WHEREAS, one of the responsibilities of the City of Ormoc is the provision of financial assistance in the total amount of Seven Hundred Thousand Philippine Pesos (PHP700,000.00) which the OLBA, in turn, shall disburse for the conduct of the aforementioned Training Seminar and Workshop subject to sound accounting rules and regulations and practices;

WHEREAS, in a Certification dated January 30, 2019 issued by the City Budget Officer, the City Planning and Development Coordinator and the City Accountant, said amount is available under the Office of the City Mayor CY 2019 MOOE account - Subsidy Others, a copy of said Certification is hereto attached as Annex "C" and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, upon close examination, this Sanggunian finds the MOA to clearly and plainly encapsulate the terms and conditions of the agreement of the parties thereto, including their specific roles and responsibilities towards the implementation and attainment of the ends of the same, and this Sanggunian further finds that the subject expenditures that the City will be shouldering is not only reasonable but also justifiable as it will immensely benefit the Barangay officials and the whole City of Ormoc in terms of much improved public service by the capacitated and trained Barangay Officials, and therefore, most deserving of this august Body's utmost support and favorable consideration;

WHEREFORE, on motion of SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos Jr., Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, severally seconded by SP Members Gregorio G. Yrastorza III, Nolito M. Quilang, Esteban V. Laurente and Jasper C. Yerro; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ OR THE ACTING CITY MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA), FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC (LGU-ORMOC), WITH THE OCCIDENTAL LEYTE BAR ASSOCIATION (OLBA) RELATIVE TO THE CONDUCT OF A TRAINING SEMINAR AND WORKSHOP FOR ALL BARANGAY OFFICIALS IN THE PREPARATION AND PASSAGE OF BARANGAY ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS, AMONG OTHERS;

The **CITY GOVERNMENT OF ORMOC**, herein referred to as Ormoc LGU, a local government unit with principal address at the New Ormoc City Hall, Aunubing Street, Ormoc City, represented herein by its Mayor, **MR. RICHARD I. GOMEZ**, hereinafter referred to the City;

The **OCCIDENTAL LEYTE BAR ASSOCIATION** herein referred to as OLBA, a non-government, non-stock, non-profit organization with principal address at Ormoc City, represented herein by _____, hereinafter referred to as the OLBA;

WITNESSETH: THAT:

WHEREAS, The OLBA is an aggrupation of lawyers residing and/or practicing and/ or with roots in the cities of Ormoc and Baybay and the municipalities of Albuer, Bato, Hilongos, Hindang, Inopacan, Isabel, Kananga, Matag- ob, Matalom, Merida, Palompon, San Isidro, Tabango and Villaba, all of Leyte, Philippines.

WHEREAS, The primary purposes for OLBA is formed are to elevate the standards of the legal profession, improve the administration of justice, and enable the Association to discharge its public responsibility more effectively being in the forefront in promoting and upholding the principles of justice and equity.

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the vital role of Barangays in nation building, serving as the primary planning and implementing unit of government policies, plans, programs, projects, and activities in the community;

WHEREAS, the City acknowledges the significance and importance of Barangays whose officials are skilled in the performance of their functions, one of which is the enactment of Barangay Ordinances;

WHEREAS, effective Barangay Ordinances can serve public interest, promote and reserve peace and order and raise revenues for the Barangays, which will benefit the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the PARTIES agree to the following:

I. Scope of Agreement

This agreement shall cover the conduct of a Seminar and Workshop for the benefit of all Ormoc Barangay officials, as to the enactment of Barangay Ordinances and the legal concerns and implications relevant to local laws.

II. Responsibilities

The following are the respective roles of the parties herein:

A. The City shall:

- a. Provide the venue, meals and financial assistance for the Seminar-Workshop in the sum of SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS, in accordance with the budget itemized as _____;
- b. Coordinate with the Department of Interior and Local Government to provide secretariat, technical and logistical support;
- c. Provide necessary technical and administrative support; and
- d. Encourage participation of key government officers and other stakeholders.

B. The OLBA shall:

- a. Provide competent and able speakers who will discuss the provisions of the Local Government Code and pertinent laws, as to the enactment of Barangay Ordinances;
- b. Provide lawyers who will handle the workshop following the said discussions; and
- c. Disburse the assistance in accordance with the conduct of the Seminar-Workshop, and present receipts thereto, subject to sound accounting practice.
