WHEREAS, this Sanggunian was in receipt of the application of Gaas Livelihood Farmers Association (GALFA), a Civil Society Organization (CSO) seeking for accreditation with the Local Government Unit of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, Gaas Livelihood Farmers Association (GALFA) is a legitimate farmers' association from Barangay Gaas, Ormoc City, duly registered under the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE). Among its objective is to establish an association that will promote mutual aid and protection to its members as well as develop a sustainable livelihood thru the conduct of activities with the aim of uplifting the economic condition of the members;

WHEREAS, it can be recalled that this Sanggunian has enacted Ordinance No. 009 dated October 16, 2014 entitled: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ACCREDITATION OF CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS (CSOs) IN THE CITY OF ORMOC" which governs the procedures for accreditation of legitimate organizations in the City of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, Section 2.1 of Ordinance 009 provides among others that an organization may still be accredited after the prescribed sixty (60) - day period within which application for accreditation shall be accepted, for purposes other than representation to local special bodies;
