A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR RICHARD I. GOMEZ OR HIS REPRESENTATIVE TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSIMADING (MOU) FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF ORMOC (LGU-CRMOC WITH THE CULTURAL CENTER OF THE PHILIPPINES (CCP) TO ESTABLISH AND/OR STRENGTHEN CCPS LINKAGES AND COOPERATION WITH THE REGIONAL EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS (), NON-GOVERNMENTAL INSTITUTIONS (NGOs) OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS (LGUs) IN ORDER TO BROADEN PUBLIC PARTICIPATION IN THE ARTS, PROMOTE AND SHOWCASE ARTISTIC EXCELLENCE AND FACILITATE A DYNAMIC COLLABORATION BETWEEN AND AMONG REGIONAL ART CENTERS (RACS).

WHEREAS, this august Body was in receipt of an Indorsement (3rd Indorsement) from the Office of the City Mayor dated February 08, 2019, and was referred to the Offices of SP Member Gregorio G. Yrastorza, III, Chairman of the Committee on Tourism, Culture and Arts and SP Member Benjamin S. Pongos, Jr., Chairman of the Committee on Laws and Ordinances, requesting therein for the issuance of a Resolution granting authority to the City Mayor Richard I. Gomez or his representative to enter into and sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for and in behalf of the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Ormoc City with the Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP), a copy of the final MOU is hereto attached and made an integral part hereof;

WHEREAS, the CCP recognizes the need to establish and/or strengthen CCP's linkages and cooperation with the regional Educational Institutions (EIs), non-governmental organizations (NGOs) or Local Government Units (LGUs) in order to broaden public participation in the arts, promote and showcase artistic excellence and facilitate a dynamic collaboration between and among Regional Art Centers (RACS);

WHEREAS, at present, there are several educational institutions and local organizations in the regions that already have existing structures, programs and facilities that can very well support and sustain various arts and cultural events and activities;

WHEREAS, the CCP through its Cultural Exchange Department (CED) has resolved to fortify a dynamic partnership with prominent educational institutions (EIs), NGOs and LGUs in Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao as one of its strategies to fulfill its cultural mission;

WHEREAS, the CCP CED conceptualized KAISA SA SINING (KSS) which will establish CCP's active regional-satellite partners in the regions by formalizing its cooperation as the CCP's Regional Art Centers (RACs) thru a Three-Year Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) that will outline the specific areas of its pertnership;

WHEREAS, LGU Ormoc, cognizant of the positive impact of the Ormoc City Fiesta 2017 and 2018 to the local economy, fully supports the conduct of this event in the city;

WHEREAS, the subject MOU clearly and plainly encapsulates the terms and conditions of the agreement of the parties thereto, including their specific roles, obligations and responsibilities for the successful conduct of the upcoming Ormoc City Fiesta Celebrations;

WHEREAS, upon close and thorough review, this Sanggunian finds that the MOU is not detrimental to the interest of the City, not contrary to law, public policy, public morals and existing contracts, and that the aim of this is highly noble, in that together the City and the CCP will be undertaking programs that will greatly benefit the inhabitants of the City, so therefore, most deserving of this august Body's full support and affirmative action:

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This contract, made and entered into this ____ day of _____, 2018, in the City of Pasay, Philippines by and between:

The CULTURAL CENTER OF THE PHILIPPINES, a government owned and controlled corporation created by P.D. 15 as amended, with principal office at the Cultural Center of the Philippines building, CCP Complex, Roxas Boulevard, Pasay City, represented herein by its President, ARSENIO J. LIZASO, hereinafter referred to as the "CCP";

The CITY GOVERNMENT OF ORMOC, a local government unit of the agro-commercial and industrial gateway in Eastern Visayas and the renewable energy capital of the Philippines which seeks to better equip individuals and communities to undertake productive pursuits as part of its development goals, with business address at Ormoc City Hall Bldg. Anubing St., Government Center \$541, Ormoc City, represented herein by its Mayor, RICHARD I. GOMEZ hereinafter referred to as "CGO".

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the CCP recognizes the need to establish and the participation in the arts and bring its programs and services closer to the people in the regions.

WHEREAS, there are at present several educational institutions and local organizations in the regions that already have existing structures, programs and facilities that can very well support and sustain various arts and cultural events and activities.

WHERE AS, the CCP through its Cultural Exchange Department (CED) has resolved to fortify a dynamic partnership with prominent educational institutions (EI), and non-government organizations (NGO) and local government units (LGUs) in Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao as one of its strategies to fulfill its cultural mission.

WHEREAS, the CCP CED conceptualized KAISA SA SINING (KSS) which will establish CCP's active regional-satellite partners in the regions by formalizing its cooperation as the CCP's Regional Art Centers (RACs) thru a Three-Year Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) that will outline the specific areas of its partnership;

WHEREAS, the CCP through KSS aims to establish and/or further strengthen CCP's linkages and cooperation with regional EIs, NGOs or LGUs in order to broaden public participation in the arts, promote and showcase artistic excellence and facilitate a dynamic collaboration between and among the RACs;

WHEREAS, the CCP and the CGO both recognize the need to forge a medium term partnership that will advance cultural and artistic development and promotions in the regions and country;

WHEREAS, the CCP has identified the CGO as one of its RACs in the region of Visayas;

WHEREAS, the CGO agrees to be one of CCP's RACs in the region of Visayas.



NOW, THEREFORE, the CCP and the CGO have hereto mutually agreed to formalize its partnership according to the specific terms and conditions stated herein:

The CCP shall assist, facilitate and provide the following to CGO: 1.

Training and apprenticeship opportunities for artists, cultural 1. workers and personnel of CGO;

2. Move-over and/or touring productions at least once a year;

Free of charge use of a CCP venue & facilities (excluding 3. operational expenses such as ushering services, ticket printing, technical crew overtime, etc.) for presentation of outstanding regional works and artists/art companies once a year depending on venue availability:

Free of charge use of the CCP CED technical equipment (lights & 4. sound system) for arts & cultural events once a year depending on availability, excluding transportation of equipment & per diem-travel

expenses of technical crew;

Complimentary copies of selected CCIP cultural resource materials 5.

to include publications and audio-video;

Free tour of the CCP building and facilities for the artists, cultural 6. workers, students, teachers/personnel of the CGC once a year for a maximum group of 50pax;

Complimentary tickets to at least 3-5 CCP produced shows per 7.

Promotion of major cultural events/activities of the CGO in the CCP 8. website Radio Program and/or E-Board; and

Participation in the CCP Annual Open House Festival and other 9. festivals.

As CCP's RAC, the CGO for its part shall assist, facilitate and provide the 11. following:

Appropriate venuels for CCP regional trainings, move-over or 1. fouring productions at least once a year;

Production, technical & logistical needs for the presentation of

move-over and/or touring productions on site;

For performances and/or trainings that the CGO will agree to present and implement in Ormoc City, the CGO will cover the corresponding fees for the artists/trainors, the rates of which will be based on a separate contract mutually agreed upon by the CCP & CGO on a per project basis;

Mobilization of audiences and participantsfor the collaborative 4. projects and activities in Ormoc City including local publicity &

marketing;


For CGO artists, performing groups and personnel sent by the 5. CGO to Manila/CCP for training or performances, the CGO will cover their travel, production & logistical expenses;

Complimentary copies of selected cultural resource materials 6. produced by the CGO for the CCP Library;

7. Information & support for cultural research work on site or in the

CCP Participation in a major annual cultural festival on site; 8.

Take the lead in the review, drafting, formulation, approval & 9. implementation of specific cultural policies relevant to the CGO and Ormoc City and provide the necessary resources and facilities.
