Gentlemen :

In view of the representations made in my letter of October 20, 1948 and in the 1st indorsement of this office, dated October 25, 1948, in connection with the question of adjustment of the salaries of the employees in this office, I have the honor to recommend that the following salary increases be approved as proposed effective November 1, 1948;

In recommending the above salary increases, the undersigned believes that it is only that way by which the efficiency of the public service can be maintained and the services of poor but properly trained personnel of long years of experience with civil service qualifications can be retained. The government is losing to business firms its efficient and highly qualified personnel due to inadequate compensation incommensurate with their positions and responsibilities.

The proposed salary increases for 5 months (from November 1, 1948 to June 30, 1949) will involve an amount of P1,640.00 only, which can be appropriated from the under-estimated revenue from the operation of markets and slaughterhouses (classification Ca-42). It will be noted from the general fund annual budget that only P46,000.00 has been estimated as market and slaughterhouse collections for the fiscal year 1948-1949, while the actual monthly average collection is over P2,000.00 or at least P48,000.00 a year. Basing upon this trend of market collections every month, there will be an over collection from the operation of markets and slaughterhouses of at least P2,000.00 at the end of the current fiscal period, from which the amount of P1,640.00 covering the proposed salary increases can be appropriated and made available. The availability of the said amount of P1,640.00 is hereby guaranteed by the undersigned.

For the purposes herein recommended, I am submitting herewith supplemental budget, general fund, for consideration and approval by that body.

The first back pay amortization due during current fiscal period will be taken care of and made available.
