RESOLUTION NO. 291

The letter of the Acting City Health Officer, this
City, dated November 18, 1948, requesting an appropriation
of from P2,000.00 to P5,000.00 for the purchase of bio-
logical products, was presented for the consideration
of the Board.

WHEREAS, the presence of smallpox cases reported
in Mindoro as per Memorandum No. A-120, Bureau of Health
Manila, dated November 8, 1948 is a warning to intensify
the vaccination campaign against smallpox in the City of
Ormoc;

WHEREAS, according to the report of the Acting
City Health Officer of this City, 2% only have been va-
ccinated against smallpox and 9% against Cholera-Typhoid
dysentery out of the 95,957 inhabitants of Ormoc City,
of the local health census.

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Councilor
Teleron, seconded by Honorable Councilor Parrilla,

BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to res-
pectfully request the Honorable Secretary, Department
of Health, Manila, that sufficient and immediate aid
be given to the inhabitants of Ormoc City, in the form
of Biological products against smallpox and cholera-
typhoid-dysentery, and

FINALLY RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution
be furnished the Honorable Director of Health, Manila
Honorable Carlos S. Tan, Senator-at-large, Honorable
Domingo Veloso, Representative, 2nd District of Leyte
and the Honorable Jose Martinez, Representative, 1st
District of Leyte, Congress of the Philippines, for
their information, cooperation and recommendation.
