RESOLUTION NO. 8

RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPAL BOARD OF ORMOC  
CITY PETITIONING HIS EXCELLENCY, PRESI-  
DENT FELPIDIO QUIRINO, FOR THE ENACT-  
MENT OF A NEW LAW GRANTING A PERIOD  
TO OWNERS OF DEFAULTED LOTS, OR  
THOSE DECLARED PUBLIC, WITHIN  
WHICH TO FILE THEIR ANSWERS

WHEREAS, thousands upon thousands of lots, agricul-  
tural, residential, or otherwise, located in Ormoc City,  
are still pending hearing, notwithstanding the lapse of  
more than twenty years from the completion of the Ormoc  
Cadastral Survey;

WHEREAS, before the outbreak of the last global  
war, the Court of First Instance came to Ormoc only once in  
a blue moon for the purpose of trying cases - civil, crimi-  
nal and cadastral - and then hardly stayed here for a week  
or two, to the regret and disappointment of the public, in  
general, and to the parties litigant, in particular;

WHEREAS, because of the brief stay here of the  
Court of First Instance during its pre-war sessions, it  
could hardly dispose of a handful of cases on the merits,  
leaving thus the cadastral cases untouched and untried;

WHEREAS, on account of the passing stays here of  
the said Court of First Instance, the owners of lots who  
were absent incapacitated or unknown could hardly be noti-  
fied to enable them to go to town, hire counsel and pre-  
pare their answers in the usual, acceptable form;

WHEREAS, due to the long intervals between the court  
sessions in Ormoc and the difficulty of getting in touch  
with the lot owners- whose whereabouts were, at times, hard  
to determine- thousands of lots, both in the city proper and

(3) For the investigation and survey of the Ormoc Irrigation System - - - 5,000.00

(4) Bao River Control, Ormoc City- - - 5,000.00

Sec. 2. Aid in the reconstruction and improvement of Ormoc City port- - - - - 40,000.00
