RESOLUTION NO. 92

The Board, on motion of Councilor Victorino C. Teleron, seconded by Councilor Guillermo T. Parrilla,

RESOLVED, That Real Street be declared two ways street to traffic during work of asphaltting Rizal Street and part of Lopez Jaena street in front of the market.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that any resolution or existing Ordinance now enforce which are in conflict with this resolution be temporarily suspended until such time as the asphaltting of the above-mentioned streets shall have been completed.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that the City Engineer Ormoc City be requested to notify the Chief of Police, Ormoc City of the date of the commencement of the temporary suspension of said ordinance and resolution for the information and guidance of traffic officers, this city.
