RESOLUTION NO. 95

On the request of Councillor Guillermo T. Parrilla, the Honorable Members of the Board gave preferential consideration to Item No. 9 of the Agenda of June 18, 1949, in view of the urgency of the matter requested by the Assistant Division Superintendent of Schools, Tacloban, Leyte in his 2nd Indorsement dated June 7, 1949. He told the Board of the presence in the Session Hall of two representatives of the PTA, District 2, Valencia, who are willing to give the Honorable Body more information on the importance of opening a general course High School in Valencia and to appeal to the Honorable members of the Municipal Board for a favorable consideration of the requested appropriation to cover a deficit of the tentative budget for operation and maintenance expenses of the proposed Valencia General Course High School.

The Chair expressed deep interest on the financial aid which the PTA of Valencia, District 2 seeks to obtain from the Municipal Board of Ormoc City. He congratulated the people of Valencia for establishing a vocational school but frankly admitted that is not well informed of the actuation of the Board in this matter.

Councillor Victorino C. Teleron, explained that the PTA District 2 of Valencia, Ormoc City of which Mr. Felix A. De Veyra, District Supervisor, is one of the enthusiastic organizers, made representation to the Municipal Board of Ormoc City and on June 19, 1948, Resolution No. 193 was approved by the Municipal Board requesting appropriation for the establishment of City Trade Vocational School at Ormoc City.

Councillor Cleto P. Evangelista told the members of the Board that the 2nd Indorsement of the Assistant Division Superintendent of Schools, Tacloban, Leyte, dated June 7, 1949, request the City Council to appropriate P8,173.60 to cover a deficit for the operation and maintenance of the proposed Valencia General Course High School as contemplated in the tentative budget. While he praised the initiative and good intention of the District Supervisor, District 2 and the spirited members of the District PTA, to his regret, he noticed in the official communications that what is proposed to establish is General Course High School in Valencia which is not in accordance with Resolution No. 193 of the Municipal Board.

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The Board, on motion of Councilor Victorino C. Teleron, seconded by Councilor Flaviano Montesclaros,

RESOLVED, That the matter be indorsed to the Division Superintendent of Schools, Tacloban, Leyte, thru the City Treasurer, Ormoc City, for comment of the latter office on the availability of funds of the City Treasurer, this City;

RESOLVED FURTHER, to request the Division Superintendent Tacloban, Leyte, that in the event of inavailability of funds of the City Treasurer of Ormoc City, recommendation be made by the Division Superintendent concerned to slash some items in the tentative budget of the proposed Valencia General Course High School so as to meet its operation and maintenance expenses within its financial capacity; and

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish one copy each, of this resolution to the City Treasurer, Ormoc City; to the Division Superintendent of Schools, Tacloban, Leyte; to the Director of Public Schools, Manila; and to Mr. Felix A. De Veyra, District Supervisor, District II, Valencia, Ormoc City, for their information and guidance.
