BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to respect-fully request His Excellency, Elpidio Quirino, President of the Republic of the Philippines, "anila, to extend to the new City Government of Ormoc an allotment in the amount of P50,000.00 from the 33 millions pesos, appro-priated for the Department of Education, to solve school crisis throughout the Philippines for the fiscal year 1949-1950;
