RESOLUTION NO. 132

1st Intorsement dated July 18, 1949 of the City Treasurer, this City and letter of Mr. Pedro Piansay, City Auditor, Ormoc City to the Municipal Board this City, the 3rd paragraph of the City Auditor's correspondence is hereunder quoted verbatim as follows:

"With regard to the special trip to the barrio made by Councilors Omega, Tugonon and Pajaron, subject of Resolution No. 118, permit me to state that said Resolution No. 118 is not sufficient to make such trip official. As I remember right, I have even approached personally someone in June 21, 1949, Councilor Tugonon, whom I met at the Session Hall and suggested to him that in order to legalize their trip it is necessary that specific resolution of the Municipal Board delegating them to perform such ministerial duties for the Board stating and specifying such duties to be performed by them. Resolution No. 118, as regards to the presence of any or all councilors in any barrio appears to be general, hence unless such resolution is approved by the Department of Interior, it is regretted that this office can not act in accordance therewith".

At this juncture, Councilor Flaviano Montesclaros manifested that the idea of the City Auditor is clear. Before going to a certain barrio on official business the Municipal Board must call special meeting solely to pass a resolution to make the trip to the barrio official stating or specifying such duties to be performed by the City Councilors.

Councilor Victorino C. Teleron strongly observed that if the idea of the City Auditor Mr. Pedro Piansay is to effect economy of the expenses of the City Government his suggestion to call special meeting of the Board before any member of the Council goes to the barrio on official business so as to legalize the expenses which in this particular case cover a voucher in the amount of P10.00 to enforce such legality and technicality the idea to effect economy is absolutely absorbed. Just imagine the expenses which the City Government will have to pay on the per diems of the City Councilors just to legalize an official trip to the barrio made by Councilors Omega, Tugonon and Pajaron, covering an amount of P10.00.
