with financial problems affecting the salaries of the teachers,
requested Mr. Yabao, the District Supervisor who happened to be
present at the Session Hall to explain why the aforementioned
teachers could not receive their full salary.

The acting District Supervisor, Mr. Yabao, explained that
payment of salary differential is authorized by Republic Acts Nos.
312 and 347 effective July 1, 1948 on National, Municipal and City
teachers. That the Director of Public Schools, Mr. Benito Pangilinan
on August 26, 1949 sent a letter to the Division Superintendent of
Schools, Tacloban, Leyte to effect the payment of salary differential
