RESOLUTION NO. 164

TO CONGRATULATE PRESIDENT ELECT HIS EXCELLENCE
ELPIDIO QUIRINO AND VICE PRESIDENT ELECT HIS
EXCELLENCY FERNANDO LOPEZ

WHEREAS, the liberal party conceived, formed and organized, by the late President Manuel A. Roxas and His Excellency, President Alpidio Quirino won the confidence of the people of the Republic of the Philippines in the national election of 1949 by elevating to the highest magistrate of the land, His Excellency the late President Manuel A. Roxas as president and His Excellency, Alpidio Quirino as vice president by overwhelming votes;

WHEREAS, upon the death of President Manuel A. Roxas, Divine Providence sanctioned by expressed constitutional mandate elevated Vice President Alpidio Quirino to lead the nation during the unexpired term of the late President;

WHEREAS, His Excellency, President Alpidio Quirino has not only shown brilliant leadership during the unexpired term of his equally brilliant and dynamic predecessor, but also demonstrated a keen grasp of the actual problem of his country when he initiated in broad stroke his total economic mobilization program intended to achieve the economic independence of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, His Excellency, President Alpidio Quirino and Senator Fernando Lopez were unanimously nominated candidates for President and Vice President respectively of the liberal party in the election held on November 8, 1949;

WHEREAS, during the strenuous campaign of the liberal party headed by Campaign Manager Honorable Eugenio Perez, fundamental political issues which would either destroy the existing democratic institution in the Philippines or save the same were discussed before the electorate, the result of which was anxiously observed outside the Philippines, specifically in Europe and in the United States;

WHEREAS, the result of the national election on November 8, 1949, the liberal party came out triumphant with an overwhelming majority over the Nationalists and Liberal Party Ayune wing thus, showing in unmistakable terms the confidence of the people in the administration of His Excellency and assuage the fear of communistic infiltration in this country;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Congress unanimously proclaim His Excellency President Elpidio Quirino and His Excellency Vice President Fernando Lopez on December 13, 1949;

NOW THEREFORE,




