RESOLUTION NO. 42

Letter of the Assistant Civil Engineer for and in
the absence of the City Engineer, Ormoc City dated March
16, 1950 addressed to the Honorable City Board thru the
City Treasurer, Ormoc City hereunder quoted verbatim
and first indorsement of the City Treasurer, Ormoc City
dated March 22, 1950 also hereunder quoted verbatim, res-
pectively, as follows:

Gentlemen:

As per instruction of the City Engineer who is still
at Manila; we are requesting that Honorable Body to ap-
propriate an additional P10,000.00 from the Road and
Bridge Fund (balance of the unappropriated amount of
P18,000.00 intended for the Panalian Bridge) to be used
for the continuation of the Asphaltting of City Streets,
project J-27-6-(2).

The above requested appropriation is intended for
the purchase of more Layte Roack As phalt together with
that for the national roads in order to procure said
asphalt at cheaper price of P35.00 per ton when we
purchase a minimum of 400 metric tons which, if less
than this quantity, would cost P45.00 per ton.

The balance as of March 16, 1950 after deducting
the cost of asphalt borrowed from the National Road
is only P427.52. Immediate action on this matter is there-
fore requested in order that the asphaltting of City
Streets will be continued.

The Board acting on the above quoted communications, on motion of Councilor Pablo S. Palaron seconded by Councilor Margarito G. Tugonon;


BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved to appropriate an additional amount of P10,000 from the Road and Bridge Fund (Balance of the unappropriated amount of P18,000 intended for the Panalian Bridge, to be used for the continuation of asphaltting city streets Project No. J-27-6 (2);


RESOLVED FURTHER to authorize, as it is hereby authorized to use a portion of the amount as above appropriated for the purchase of more Leyte Rock Asphalt of not less than 400 metric tons of first class quality at P25.00 per ton, and authorizing said City Engineer to return such quantity of asphalt borrowed from asphaltting national road as stated in the above quoted letter of the Assistant City Engineer;

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, to respectfully request the City Engineer, Ormoc City that in asphaltting city streets in the appropriation above intended, the City Engineer should first finish the asphaltting of Bonifacio and Rizal streets, then Solidor street and the remaining appropriation herein intended, be used in asphaltting that part of the road going to Ipil;




