
As per instruction of the City Engineer who is still at Manila; we are requesting that Honorable Body to appropriate an additional P10,000.00 from the Road and Bridge Fund(balance of the unappropriated amount of P18,000.00 intended for the Panalian Bridge) to be used for the continuation of the Asphalting of City Streets, project J-27-6-(2).

The above requested appropriation is intended for the purchase of more Leyte Roack As phalt together with that for the national roads in order to procure said asphalt at cheaper price of P35.00 per ton when we purchase a minimum of 400 metric tons which, if less than this quantity, would cost P45.00 per ton.

The balance as of March 16,1950 after deducting the cost of asphalt borrowed from the National Road is only P427.52. Immediate action on this matter is therefore requested in order that the asphalting of City Streets will be continued.
