BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to respectfully request His Excellency President Elpidio Quirino of the Republic of the Philippines to issue an executive order amending Executive Order No. 180, on classification of road at Ormoc City/adding as number 4 Ormoc-Albuera Road as a continuation of Palo-Carigara-Ormoc Road;

BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, in approving the recommendation of the City Engineer is motivated by its honest intention to serve the best interest of the people of the 58 barrios which comprise the city of Ormoc to provide for them with vecinal roads;

BE IT RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that considering the limited fimancial capacity of the City of Ormoc and considering further the vast construction of barrio road projects of His Honor, the City Mayor which is an implementation of the total mobilization program of His Excellency President Elpidio Quirno, the amendment of Executive Order No. 180 hereby earnestly requested to increase to number 4 as Ormoc-Albuera Road (as continuation of Palo-Carigara-Ormoc Road) the recommendation of the City Engineer of Ormoc City approved by unanimity of the Board concerned would be a sort of national aid extended to the city government of Ormoc which would ultimately redown to the (Excerpt frin the minutes of the Municipal Board held on March 25, 1950)
