RESOLUTION NO. 50

WHEREAS, the City Engineer of Ormoc City, in the session hall of the Municipal Board, this city on March 25, 1950 officially informed the Honorable Body that Executive Order No. 180 of His Excellency President Elpidio Quirino dated October 9, 1948, establishing classification of national roads, the City of Ormoc has the following classification of road as national, as follows:

1. Palo-Carigara-Ormoc Road
2. Libungao-Palompun Road
3. Ormoc Cadre Road

WHEREAS, the City Engineer of Ormoc City during the deliberation of the Board on the date above mentioned, respectfully suggested to the Honorable Body to pass a resolution requesting His Excellency President Elpidio Quirino of the Philippines to establish and classify as a national road, the Ormoc-Albuera Road as a continuation of Palo-Carigara-Ormoc Road;

NOW THEREFORE,

The Board, on motion of Councilor Flaviano Montesclaros seconded by Councilor Antonio C. Cataag;

BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to respectfully request His Excellency President Elpidio Quirino of the Republic of the Philippines to issue an executive order amending Executive Order No. 180, on classification of road at Ormoc City/adding as number 4 Ormoc-Albuera Road as a continuation of Palo-Carigara-Ormoc Road;

BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, in approving the recommendation of the City Engineer is motivated by its honest intention to serve the best interest of the people of the 58 barrios which comprise the city of Ormoc to provide for them with vecinal roads;

BE IT RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that considering the limited financial capacity of the City of Ormoc and considering further the vast construction of barrio road projects of His Honor, the City Mayor which is an implementation of the total mobilization program of His Excellency President Elpidio Quirino, the amendment of Executive Order No. 180 hereby earnestly requested to increase to number 4 as Ormoc-Albuera Road (as continuation of Palo-Carigara-Ormoc Road) the recommendation of the City Engineer of Ormoc City approved by unanimity of the Board concerned would be a sort of national aid extended to the city government of Ormoc which would ultimately redound to the

benefit of the 80,000 population of Ormoc City whose principal productions are rice, corn, abaca, tobacco, sugarcane and utilization of forest products by a number of lumber mills settled in different barrios;

Mariano Jesus Cuenco, President Philippine Senate, Manila; the Director of Public Works, Manila; the District Engineer of Leyte, Tacloban, Leyte; the City Mayor, Ormoc City; the City Treasurer, Ormoc City and the City Engineer, Ormoc City.
