Dear Secretary Baluyut:

I would like to recommend approval of the request of the City of Ormoc to get arms equipments in order to carry more effectively the peace and order program envisaged by the administration in the sector surrounding Ormoc City which was lately the scene of another dissident depredation. I am informed by the Mayor of said city in my trip to Leyte that all the necessary papers relative to the request are now in your office. I hope you will give this matter serious consideration.

12 - US Carbine Cal. 30 M-1
24 - US Rifle Cal. 30 M-1 (Garrand)

Ammunitions needed:

1,000 - Rds. 38 Cal. (Revolver)
6,000 - " 45 Cal. (Pistol)
2,500 - " 30 Cal. (US Carbine M-1)
5,000 - " 30 Cal. (US Rifle M-1)


