RESOLUTION NO. 113

Letter of Dr. Petronilo L. Torres, City Health Officer,
Ormoc City dated July 6, 1950 to the Honorable Municipal Board thru
His Honor, the City Mayor, Ormoc City hereunder quoted verbatim as
follows:

S i r s:

In view of the fact that almost all houses along the beach
just at the back of the City Hall and in Sabang district of this
City are not provided with sanitary toilets due to difficulty of
constructing them in such sandy soil, I have the honor to recom-
mend the construction of two public sheds, one in each district
to be defrayed with whatever surplus money the health department
had saved out of the last year appropriation. If this surplus
money is not sufficient, I request the Hon. Municipal Board to
appropriate sufficient amount for their completion. These maiden
sheds should be made of septic vault, big enough to accommodate
at least six seats, three for male and three for female.

According to the estimate of the office of City Engineer,
each of them may cost about P1,500.00 including the shade made of
strong materials and galvanized iron roofing with water and light
installations.

In this connection, a permanent laborer or employee should
be provided with compensation at the rate of P600.00 a year whose
work is to take care of these public toilets including the public
market toilets, and to maintain them always clean and sanitary.

Hoping for your favorable action on this important public
health project.

The Board acting on the above quoted letter on motion of Councillor Flaviano Montecelares seconded by Councillor Antonio G. Cateag;

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved to appropriate P3,600 for the construction of two public sheds, one at the back of the City Hall and another one in Sabang District of this city, the same should be made of septic vault, big enough to accommodate six seats, 3 for male and 3 for female, estimated to cost about P1,500 each including shade made of strong materials and galvanized iron roofing with water and light installations, thus making a total of P3,000; and the remaining P600 is hereby appropriated for salary of a permanent laborer or an employee with a compensation at the rate of P600 a year, whose work is to take care of these public toilets including the public market toilets and to maintain them always clean and sanitary;

BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER, that the amount of P3,600 as above appropriated be taken from whatever surplus money the Health Department of Ormoc City had saved out of last years appropriation;

BE IT RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that if the surplus money savings of said Health Department of Ormoc City is not sufficient for the construction of the sanitary toilets above mentioned, the Municipal Board shall appropriate sufficient amount for their completion to be taken from the general fund of the city government;

BE IT RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copy of this resolution each to the City Mayor, Ormoc City; the City Treasurer, Ormoc City; the City Auditor, Ormoc City; the City Health Officer, Ormoc City; and to the City Engineer, Ormoc City.

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

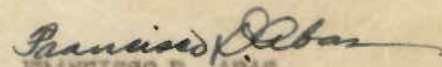
