RESOLUTION NO. 2

WHEREAS, His Honor, the City Mayor informed the Board that on January 6, 1951 he filed administrative charges against seven members of the uniformed and secret servicemen of the Police Force, Ormoc City for neglect in the performance of their duties under the provincial circular numbered as implementation of the provisions of Act No. 557.

WHEREAS, the City Mayor, further informed the Board, as an investigating Body under the Act aforementioned that after reinvestigation of the charges, he found out that the three secret servicemen, namely, Felix Eamiguel, Felix Guillermer and Jose Esmero were not assign in the market where the stealing took place but their assignment was in an area apart from the market and therefore, requested the Board to drop his charges in so far as the three secret service men are concerned;

WHEREAS, the City Mayor finally, requested the investigating Body to hold in abeyance the hearing against the case of the four policemen (in uniform) affected because he believes that there is another person who is directly responsible;

WHEREFORE;

The Board, on motion of Vice-Mayor Marcelo D. Bandalan, seconded by Councilor Felipe Adolfo;

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved to dismiss the case against Felix Eamiguel, Felix Guillermer and Jose Esmero as recommended by the City Mayor on the ground aforementioned;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the three secret servicemen aforementioned be reinstated at once with right to receive their corresponding salaries during the time of their suspension.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, to hold in abeyance the investigation of the four policemen in uniform, namely Pascasio Sungahid, Exaquil Maffago, Agapito Payod and Marcelino Laguna for further reinvestigation of the case against them;

FINALLY RESOLVED, to furnish copy of this resolution each to the City Mayor, Ormoc City; to the City Treasurer, Ormoc City; to the City Auditor, Ormoc City; to the Chief of Police, Ormoc City and to each and every member of the secret servicemen and four members of the Police Force in uniform, Ormoc City for their information and guidance.
