2nd Indorsement dated January 18, 1951, Hon. Felipe Adelfo, Chairman of the Committee on Schools, Municipal Board, Ormoc City hereunder quoted verbatim as follows:

Respectfully returned to the Municipal Board, Ormoc City, recommending approval of the reversion of funds as contained in the attached basic communication of the city supervisor, dated January 6, 1951.

After conferring with the city supervisor on January 16, 1951, the following information re-the case had been obtained:

- (a) D-21-f - P970.00 - That this amount will be used to help cover the expenses incurred in connection with the Ormoc City representation Elem. Athletic Meets in Albura, Naval, Marikina and Tacloban which aggregated to more than One Thousand Pesos. This was partly met through voluntary contributions.
- (b) D-21-g - P500.00 Aside the supplies and materials which the district officer will use, the city supervisor plans to utilize a part of this fund to administer a District Test during this school year, 1950-1951.
- (c) D-21-l - P80.00 and D-21-t P70.00 - These items have been found necessary and the amounts recommended for reversion are reasonable.

That all items which have been requested for reversion belong to the school funds and the items to which the reversion shall be made are school items which require urgent attention and consideration. Hence, the management of the District Supervisor in making adjustments to solve his immediate school problems with the use of the same funds under his jurisdiction and care, deserve to gain the Board's respect and approval.

FINALLY RESOLVED, to furnish copy of this resolution each to the City Mayor, Ormoc City; to the City Treasurer, Ormoc City; to the City Auditor, Ormoc City and to Mr. Felix De Veyra, City Supervisor, Ormoc City.
