D-21-1- P80.00 and D-21-t P70.00 - These items have (c) been found necessary and the amounts recommended for reversion are reasonable.

That all items which have been requested for reversion belong to the school funds and the items to which the reversion shall be made are school items which require urgent attention and consideration. Hence, the management of the District Supervisor in making addustments to solve his immediate school problems with the use of the same funds under his jurisdiction and care, deserve to gain the Board's respect and approval.
