RESOLUTION NO. 12

WHEREAS, Hon. Congressman Domingo Veloso, Speaker Pro-tempore, House of the Representative in his communication dated January 10, 1951 to his Hon. the City Mayor of Ormoc City has requested said City Mayor to advise him (Domingo Veloso) on the stand of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City on the proposed amendment of Republic Act No. 542, creating the Municipality of Cananga by amending Sec. 1 of said Republic Act so as to include Barrios of Laya, Cananga, Rizal, Tugbong, Montebello Agutina, Mayayay, Montalegre, Libuigao, Maghaling, Naticaa and Monte Rico to the Municipal Charter of Cananga with the seat of government in the Barrio of Libuigao, thus separating the last two barrios of Naticaa and Monte Rico from the city of Ormoc;

AND WHEREAS, Section 2 of said Republic Act also proposed to amend that Barrio Nasarayao which is included in the Municipality of Cananga, is to be transferred to the city of Ormoc;

BE IT THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councillor Porfirio Ayuyao, seconded by Councillor Antonio C. Cataag;

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved, to respectfully convey to Hon. Congressman Domingo Veloso that the Municipal Board of Ormoc City is strongly against the amendment of Sec. 1 of said Republic Act No. 542, specifically the inclusion of the Barrio of Naticaa and Barrio Monte Rico to the Municipality of Cananga;

RESOLVED FURTHER, to respectfully inform Congressman Domingo Veloso that the Municipal Board of Ormoc City has no objection and hereby appreciates his intention of amending Sec. 2 of said Republic Act by returning the Barrio of Nasarayao to the City of Ormoc;

BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER, to respectfully request the City Engineer of Ormoc City to make a map or sketch and submit the same to the Municipal Board, this City immediately showing in said sketch or map the Barrio of Nasarayao, Monterice, and Naticaa and the two rivers of Das and Pagsaiguan, indicating therein, the boundaries of the Municipality of Cananga and the City of Ormoc wherein it should appear in said sketch or map the Barrios of Monterice and Naticaa which is sought to be included in the Municipal Charter of Cananga.
