RESOLUTION NO. 19

WHEREAS, it is a long felt problem of the Municipal Officials of Ormoc City to satisfy the crying needs of the barrio people of this City for artesian wells to give them safe drinking water facility necessary for their daily need.

WHEREAS, fortunately enough, the present administration has finally taken cognizance of the imperative necessity to provide for the people throughout the Philippines, the much needed safeguard to the people's health, the construction of artesian wells for every 5,000 population, and in line with the present program of His Excellency, the President of the Philippines, the Director of Health, implementing the program of artesian well construction, is now preparing to submit to the present Philippine Congress the necessary appropriation needed to carry out this vast project;

WHEREAS, be it known that according to the last census Ormoc City has a population of 72,733 and considering that the present project along this line provided for one artesian well for every 5,000 population, the Municipal Board of Ormoc City hereby respectfully submits to the Hon. Director of Health, Manila; to include the City of Ormoc in his recommendation to the Philippine Congress, the construction of 16 artesian wells;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Flaviano Montesclaros, seconded by Councilor Porfirio Ayuyao;

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved, to respectfully request the Director of Health, Manila; to provide 16 artesian wells for Ormoc City in line with the vast program of His Excellency, the President of the Philippines, now implemented by the Director of Health so that the crying needs of the barrio people of this city whose drinking water are secured from rivers and brooks which are generally unsafe would be finally satisfied.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to furnish copy of this resolution each to His Excellency, the President of the Philippines, Malacañan Palace, Manila; to Hon. Mariano Jesus Cuenco,
