RESOLUTION NO. 12

Letter of the Market Superintendent, Ormoc City dated March 21, 1951 and 1st Indorsement of the City Treasurer, Ormoc City dated March 27, 1951 hereunder quoted verbatim respectively as follows:

Sir:

I have the honor to inform you that the additional market building of this city will be turn over to the government today. Since there is no Market Committee created, I the undersigned request that a definite instruction be given to me in order that proper step be taken to solve delay of occupancy.

In my humble opinion if there is no opposition the said building will be for fish sections (Fresh, Dried and Salted). In the fresh fish section it is very important that the government should provide cement tables, in order to avoid trouble in the fish area which is occurring every day.

The Engineering Department has furnished plan and estimate of said tables for more than ONE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED (P1,300.00) PESOS to the City Treasurer of this city.

In the Dried and Salted Fish Section it is still very important to provide wooden tables in order to have uniformity and accuracy of collection.

In this connection I pray that a certain amount to cover the above expenses be set by the authority concern.

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved, to approve the request of the market superintendent in the communication above quoted as indorsed favorably by the city treasurer, appropriating the sum of P1,400 for the construction of concrete tables for the use of fish vendors in said market extension tiendas in the plans and specifications submitted by the city engineer, Ormoc City;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the amount of P1,400 as above appropriated be taken partly from the balance of P23,000 appropriated for the construction of Market Wenda Extension in the amount of P1,000 as certified to by the City Engineer, Ormoc City on March 29, 1951;

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that the sum of P400 to complete the P1,400 as above appropriated be taken from any fund of the city treasurer, Ormoc City, not otherwise appropriated;

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copy of this resolution each to the City Mayor, Ormoc City; to the City Treasurer, Ormoc City; to the City Auditor, Ormoc City; to the City Engineer, Ormoc City; and to the Market Superintendent, Ormoc City.
