RESOLUTION NO. 44

Letter of the City Health Officer dated March 16, 1951  
and 1st Indorsement of the City Treasurer, Ormoc City dated  
March 17, 1951, hereunder quoted verbatim respectively as  
follows:

S i r s :

Inasmuch as the activities of Health Department are  
both in the Public Dispensary and in the field, it could not  
be denied that in the field works it would incur expenses  
for the personnel in transportation and per diems. In my  
capacity as City Health Officer, I wish to make an explan-  
ation before the Hon. Board, the necessary appropriation  
for the exigencies of the service.

The Director of Health has recently circularized all  
District Health Officers and City Health Officers in the  
archipelago concerning the tentative plan to have an Annual  
Convention of all District Health Officers, City Health Officers,  
School Physicians and School Dentists during the later part  
of April for about seven days in Manila, to treat health mat-  
ters of vital importance, specially the transfer of super-  
vision and control of school physicians and dentists to the  
Bureau of Health under Executive Order No. 5 of His Excel-  
lency, the President of the Philippines. Last year there  
was no Annual Convention, so that, the convention is neces-  
sary. The probable amount to be incurred is estimated to  
P260.00 including transportation and per diems in Manila.

From the Senior Health Inspector at Cebu, this Office has been advised to send two representatives to take First Aid Training Course for a week in Cebu, and it will incur too, about P100.00. This training course in First Aid will include Sanitary Inspectors all the provinces and cities in the Eastern Visayas.

From this writing to the end of this fiscal year by June 1951 there would be still unforeseen traveling expenses, so that, this office estimates P90.00 for that item. Actually there is an overdraft of about P350.00 needing also appropriation.

Summarizing the amount needed for appropriation, it gives a total of P800.00. This amount is badly needed to meet the purposes explained above. Compared with last year appropriation of P1500.00 for traveling expenses and per diems, this year budget provided P500.00 only at first and lately P260.00, giving a total of P760.00 in all, which is about 1/2 of the last year appropriation. Therefore, I wish to request the Hon. Board that an additional appropriation of P800.00 be approved.

To meet this P800.00, I wish to suggest Hon. Body if there is no objection to get this amount from different sources for reversion:

a. Gain from the sales of streptomycin -	P275.00
b. Salary saving unreverted from two sanitary inspectors, P190.00, but total saving was P150.00 and P260.00 was reverted recently	190.00
c. Salary saving of City Health Officer, from January 16 to February 15, 1951, 1 mo. -	250.00
d. Another probable salary saving of City Health Officer from Apr. 5-20, 1951 (1/2 Mo.) who will be on vacation without pay and approved by the Director of Health amounts of P125.00, but P85 only to be reverted for this purpose - - - - -	P 85.00
TOTAL - - - - -	P 800.00

In view of the foregoing explanation, I request the Hon. Board that the facts as presented be given due consideration in order that the plan of this office may be realized for the welfare and success of the administration.


