RESOLUTION NO. 58

WHEREAS, the market superintendent, Mr. Francisco Arradaza requested the Municipal Board, this city to construct wooden tables for dried and salted fish at the expense of the city government, in order that said wooden tables would be uniformed and market collection for this fees would not be paralyzed nor lessened.

WHEREAS, on deliberation of the Board in connection with the suggestion of said market superintendent, the Chair manifested that the appropriation requested would be beyond the capacity of the government to finance the project;

WHEREAS, on the suggestion of Councilor Teleron, a solution was introduced to materialized said project, such that the construction of uniform wooden tables should be done at the expense of the dried and salted fish vendors which plans and specifications should be recommended by the market superintendent subject to the approval of the city engineer concern and which expenses for said wooden tables as advanced by the interested party should be gradually reimbursed by exempting from payment of daily market fees in favor of the interested fish vendors up to the time the whole expenses for said wooden table shall have been completely covered and reimbursed in which case said wooden tables would become automatically the property of the city Government of Ormoc City;

NOW THEREFORE,

The Board, on motion of Councilor Felipe Adolfo, seconded by Councilor Victorino C. Teleron;

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved, to approve the suggestion of Councilor Victorino C. Teleron that the construction of wooden table for dried and salted fish vendors for use in the new market extension be made at the expense of the salted and dried fish vendors which plans and specifications for said wooden table shall be made on the suggestion of the market superintendent subject to the approval of the city engineer, Ormoc City and the uniform expenses incurred for said wooden table for each and every market vendors for dried and salted fish, shall be gradually

reimbursed by exempting from payment of the daily market fees in favor of the interested fish vendors until the whole expenses shall have been fully covered or reimbursed in which case the ownership of said wooden tables shall become automatically the property of the city government of Ormoc.

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copy of this resolution each to the city Mayor, Ormoc City; to the City Treasurer, Ormoc City; to the City Auditor, Ormoc City; to the City Engineer, Ormoc City; and to the Market Superintendent, Ormoc City.
