RESOLUTION NO. 65

WHEREAS, it has come to the official knowledge of the Municipal Board of this City that many city streets are not yet provided with garbage can for dumping the garbage of the people;

WHEREAS, be it known that the disposal of garbage in the City proper has become a problem to the City Health Department due to the recurrent violation of sanitary rules and regulation and it is thought that the proper solution of the problem is to provide more garbage cans all along the City Streets and National highway within the Poblacion of this City;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Victorino C. Teleron, seconded by Councilor Pablo S. Pajaron;

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved, that each and every City Councilors of the City of Ormoc should campaign to ask voluntary donation of empty gasoline drums from the different gasoline stations within the City proper and Civic organization or from any civic spirited citizens of the City so that our City Streets and National Highway within the city proper could be provided with garbage cans;

RESOLVED FURTHER, to respectfully request the proprietors of gasoline station established within the city proper and the President of Civic organization and Civic spirited citizens to cooperate with the City authorities on the problem of the disposal of garbage to give voluntary contribution to the City Councilors under the Chairmanship of Hon. Victorino C. Teleron who are now campaigning for empty gasoline drums so that with their earnest cooperation in the interest of sanitation our public health could be safeguarded;

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copy of this resolution each to the City Mayor, Ormoc City; to the City Treasurer, Ormoc City; to the City Auditor, Ormoc City; and to all proprietors of the gasoline station established within the city proper and other civic organization.
