RESOLUTION NO. 75

WHEREAS, the decision of the Chairman of the Committee on Laws and Ordinances, Hon. Cleto P. Evangelista in the administrative case unnumbered for neglect in the performance of duties under Republic Act 557 wherein Hon. Lucilo A. Conui as Mayor of Ormoc City, complainant versus Pascasio Sungahid, Exequiel Mafago, Agapito Payud and Marcelino Laguna, respondents, the same was submitted to the Hon. Municipal Board on May 12, 1951, the dispositive part of which hereunder quoted verbatim, as follows:

"Considering however the circumstances of the case, suspension for 15 days without pay would be sufficient punishment for the respondents Agapito Payud and Marcelino Laguna with the warning that a similar offense in the future on their part would be dealt with more severely. Respondent Pascasio Sungahid and Exequiel Mafago be exonerated."

WHEREAS, on May 19, 1951 the respondents in the above case after due notification, appeared before the Hon. Municipal Board, this City for the reading of the decision against them and were duly informed further that they could appeal the case within 15 days from the date of the receipt of the decision to the Commissioner of Civil Service, Manila, specifically on respondents Agapito Payud and Marcelino Laguna, found guilty for neglect in the performance of their official duties;

WHEREAS, on submission of the above quoted decision to the Municipal Board and upon deliberation of the same by the Hon. Body, it was strongly suggested by Councilor Felipe Adolfo that the decision imposing a suspension of 15 days should be modified;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Felipe Adolfo, seconded by Councilor Guillermo T. Parrilla;

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved, to modify the decision submitted by the Chairman of the Committee on Laws and Ordinances Hon. Cleto P. Evangelista, that instead of 15 days suspension, the respondents Agapito Payud and Marcelino Laguna be suspended only for five (5) days without pay, with the warning that a similar offense in the future on their part would be dealt with more severely;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that inasmuch as respondents Agapito Payud and Marcelino Laguna, found guilty of this administrative charges were already suspended for thirty (30) days in the month of January, 1951, the five (5) days suspension hereby imposed upon said respondents be deducted from the thirty (30) days abovementioned so that respondents Agapito Payud and Marcelino Laguna should be paid for the remaining 25 days of their salary corresponding to the month of January, 1951;

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, to acquit respondents Pascasio Sungahid and Exequiel Mafingo thus exonerating them from this administrative charges;

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copy of this resolution each to the City Mayor, Ormoc City; to the City Treasurer, Ormoc City; to the City Auditor, Ormoc City; to the Chief of Police, Ormoc City and to the respondents Agapito Payud and Marcelino Laguna.
