Cabrera in connection with the damage to the pier of Ormoc City caused by Motor Boat Carmen owned by the Aboitiz & Co. is until date unsettled and considering the elapse of time which until now the city government of Ormoc City is not yet satisfied of her effort to demand justice for the damage of said pier, the Board, on motion of Councillor Felipe Adolfo, seconded by Councillor Pablo S. Pajaron;

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved, to respectfully request the manager of the Aboitiz & Co. to give justice to the city of Ormoc in her demand for equitable damages on the destruction of Ormoc Pier caused by Motor Boat Carmen which is owned by said Aboitiz & Co;

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, to respectfully appeal to said Aboitiz & Co. thru its manager, Don Ramon Aboitiz, Cebu City to give special attention to the present appeal on humanitarian ground considering that the Aboitiz & Co. has a business interest in the City of Ormoc being the owner of the Ormoc Electric Plant;



Toribio Pedrosa, City Attorney, Ormoc City to renew the negotiation with the Aboitiz & Co. thru its manager Don Ramon Aboitiz or any of his authorized delegates to settle extrajudicially the claim for damages of the City of Ormoc against the said Aboitiz Co. for the damage on the pier done by Motor Boat Carmen in the year 1948;


