RESOLUTION NO. 123

WHEREAS, the City of Ormoc was completely razed to the ground during the fight for liberation and its historical significance on the occasion of the landing of the American forces on October 20 now being commemorated and made official holiday by His Excellency the President of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, in that fight for liberation, all the asphalted streets of the then municipality of Ormoc were completely destroyed and until date many streets are still not asphalted specifically the Mabini Street, William Bryant Street, San Vicente Street, Lopez Jaena Street, Solidor Street, San Agustin Street, etc.

WHEREAS, Section 1 sub-section "h" item 66 of Republic Act 670 carries an appropriation of P25,000 for asphaltting Osmeña Street, Bonifacio Street, William Bryant Street and San Agustin Street, and Rizal Street, of Ormoc City which item His Excellency the President of the Philippines has vetoed;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councillor Felipe Adolfo seconded by Councillor Porfirio Ayuyao;

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved to respectfully request His Excellency, President Elpidio Quirino, President of the Philippines, Malacañan Palace, Manila, to reconsider his veto on Section 1 subsection "h" of item 66 of the appropriation Act aforementioned and that the amount of P25,000.00 there appropriated for asphaltting city streets of Ormoc City be given due course the same being badly needed to rehabilitate the city streets specifically Mabini Street, William Bryant Street, San Vicente Street, Lopez Jaena Street, Solidor Street, San Agustin Street, etc. and for the further reason that the repair of the streets aforementioned has already been given much publicity and therefore, it would be embarrassing to the city officials to the eyes of the people of Ormoc if these streets which need complete rehabilitation could not be carried out;

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, to respectfully request Hon. Domingo Veloso, Speaker Protempore, House of the Representatives, Manila and Hon. Eugenio Perez, Speaker, House of the Representatives, Manila requesting them to make representation to His Excellency the President to reconsider his veto on the items aforementioned for the reasons above stated;

RESOLVED FINALLY, to respectfully request the Speaker and the Speaker Protempore of the House of the Representatives, Manila, to exert efforts on the early release of the amount aforementioned;

Let copies of this resolution be furnished each to His Excellency, President Elpidio Quirino Malacañan Palace, Manila; the Hon. Secretary of Public Works and Communications, Manila; City Mayor, Ormoc City, City Treasurer, Ormoc City; City Auditor, Ormoc City and the City Engineer, Ormoc City.
