Letter of Mr. Pablo S. Macariola, Provincial Agricultural Supervisor, Tacloban, Leyte dated Oct. 23, 1951 hereunder quoted verbatim as follows:

Sir:

Please be advised that the Fertilizer Administrator, thru this Office will sell to the farmers of Ormoc and its neighboring municipalities, several bags of ammonium phosphate fertilizer. In this connection, please inform this office if we can have storage room and facility of about 250 bags monthly shipment within the compound of the city government building for this purpose.

As this shipment comes direct from Manila and same to be unloaded directly at Ormoc City very soon, please send your advice thru our Municipal Agricultural Inspector, Mr. F. Reforzado.

Please be guided accordingly.

WHEREAS, on 3rd indorsement dated Oct. 26, 1951 of the City Agronomist, Ormoc City, the Municipal Board of Ormoc City was finally convinced of the advantages and the benefit that the city of Ormoc would derived from selling said fertilizer for the farmers of Ormoc City and neighboring municipalities and, therefore, expressed its conformity on the suggestion expressed in the communication above quoted and providing facilities and storage room for said fertilizer within the compound of the city government building;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Felipe Adolfo, seconded by Councilor Porfirio Ayuyao;

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved to authorize the City Agronomist, Mr. Protasio Escoro to advise the Provincial Agricultural Inspector Mr. Pablo V. Macariola thru the Municipal Agricultural Inspector, Mr. F. Referzado of the acceptance of the board on the request stated in the above quoted communication and to provide storage room and facility of said fertilizer within the compound of the city government building;

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copy of this resolution each to the City Mayor, Ormoc City, City Treasurer, Ormoc City; City Auditor, Ormoc City and the City Agronomist, Ormoc City.
