RESOLUTION NO. 181

WHEREAS, on the suggestion of Councilor Porfirio Ayuyao that San Joaquin, San Jorge, San Vidal and San Nicolas Streets be extended so as to connect them to Bonifacio Street extension, except Solidor Street and that a new street be constructed from the foot or end of Cantubo bridge passing almost along the dike which new street, as wide as wide as the national road, up to Bonifacio Street extension;

NOW THEREFORE,

The Board, on motion of Councilor Porfirio Ayuyao, seconded by Councilor Flaviano Montesclaros;

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved to approve the suggestion of Councilor Porfirio Ayuyao to extend San Joaquin, San Jorge, San Vidal and San Nicolas streets so as to connect them to Bonifacio Street extension, except Solidor Street;

RESOLVED FURTHER, to construct a new street from the foot or end of Cantubo Bridge passing almost along the dike, the same to be as wide as a national road to connect said new street with Bonifacio Street extension.

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copy of this resolution to the City Mayor, Ormoc City; City Treasurer, Ormoc City; City Auditor, Ormoc City and the City Engineer, Ormoc City.
