RESOLUTION NO. 194

WHEREAS, Vice Mayor Marcelo D. Bandalan, Presiding Officer and Acting City Mayor deeply concerned with the creation of the Office of City Superintendent of Schools for Orcoc City has authorized by Republic Act No. 640 approved on June 11, 1951 and manifesting further that Resolution No. 192 approved by majority votes of the members present during its special session on December 13, 1951 was not sanctioned by the required six affirmative votes of the Councillors present as required by the City Charter, otherwise known as Republic Act No. 179, in order to legally create the aforementioned Office of City Superintendent of Schools for the City of Orcoc;

BE IT RESOLVED, the Board, on motion of Councillor Porferio Ayuyao, seconded by Councillor Pablo S. Pajaron;

BE IT FURTHER, as is hereby resolved to revive the consideration of Resolution No. 192 aforementioned in order to carry its technical intent;

RESOLVE FURTHER, that in order to effectively carry out the purpose of the Board to create a position of the Office of City Superintendent of Schools for Orcoc City, the Board hereby ^{asst.} appropriated an annual salary of P5,000.00 per annum for the position of the Office of City Superintendent of Schools for Orcoc City effective January 1, 1952 to June 30, 1952, the same being authorized by Republic Act No. 640 approved on June 11, 1951;

RESOLVE FURTHER, that the amount as above appropriated be taken from the sum set aside for the salary differential of City Supervisors and Principals of Orcoc City authorized by Resolution No. 32 dated April 7, 1951 which resolution was declared illegal by the Auditor General per 6th Inter-complaint dated November 7, 1951 attached to voucher in question;

RESOLVE FINALLY, to respectfully request Hon. Romulo Tolosa Speaker Protempore, House of the Representatives, Manila to sponsor an amendment of Republic Act No. 179 creating the Chartered City of Orcoc to the effect that the supervision of the Division Superintendent of Schools, Tacloban, Leyte over the

primary and intermediate schools of Ormoc City be withdrawn, the same to be under the direct supervision of the City Superintendent of Schools of Ormoc City in compliance with the provision of Republic Act No. 640 approved on June 11, 1951;
