In justice and fairness thim, he should be allowed to continue to serve as Secretary to the Board;

3.- Mr. Ramon Bantasan does not enjoy the confidence of the Presiding Officer which is very necessary by nature of their respective positions.

It is therefore the opinion of the undersigned that once a resolution appointing the Secretary to the Board is approved by the Municipal Board, it is ministerial on the part of the Presiding Officer, to make the appointment but discretionary as to the person who shall fill the office without being bound by a resolution of the Board naming the person desired to be appointed.
