RESOLUTION NO. 5

WHEREAS, the finances of the City of Ormoc is in a precarious condition on account of the employment of excessive employees in non-essential services;

WHEREAS, according to the records of the City Treasurer, the City of Ormoc is now suffering actually a deficit of more than P15,000.00 which, at the end of the present fiscal year, may amount to more than P40,000 if the services of aforesaid excessive employees in non-essential services be continued;

WHEREAS, the fiscal budget of the City of Ormoc for the fiscal year 1951-1952 has been partly disapproved by the Department of Finance in accordance with the letter of Undersecretary Sixto B. Ortiz dated November 5, 1951 in a letter to the Municipal Board of this City for the reason that the present fiscal budget approved by the outgoing Municipal Board has exceeded by around more than P39,000.00 in view of its failure to provide therein five percent reserve required by existing laws and regulations in the Department of Finance;

WHEREAS, on account of the unsound fiscal policy adopted by the outgoing Municipal Board, the school fund appropriation for Ormoc District I and District II have been reported to be incurring this present academic year a probable deficit of more than P24,000.00 and P16,000.00 respectively;

WHEREAS, it is a sound fiscal policy that every centavo paid by a taxpayer to the treasury of the City of Ormoc must necessarily be returned to him in the form of essential services and public improvements; on the contrary, the present fiscal budget merely provides only for a negligible amount for public improvements of the City;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Esteban C. Conejos, seconded by Councilor Alvaro I. Gutierrez;

BE IT RESOLVED, as is hereby resolved that a Committee on Reorganization be created whose members thereat shall compose of Honorable Victorino C. Teleron as Chairman; and Honorable Councilors Guillermo T. Parrilla and Alvaro I. Gutierrez as members, who shall be invested

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with power to recommend for the reorganization of the different services of the City Government of Ormoc, and the abolition of such services and the corresponding appropriations therefor as, in its opinion, are non-essential services with a view to effect economy in the city finances as well as to ward off the expected deficits in the city finances;

RESOLVED FINALLY, to furnish copy of this resolution each to His Excellency, President of the Philippines, Malacañan Palace, Manila; Hon. Secretary of the Department of Finance, Manila; the City Mayor, Ormoc City; the City Treasurer, Ormoc City and City Auditor, Ormoc City.

VETO OF RESOLUTION NO. 5, CURRENT SERIES,
OF THE HONORABLE MUNICIPAL BOARD
OF ORMOC CITY, PURSUANT TO
REP. ACT 179

The undersigned vetoes Res. No. 5, current series, of the Honorable Municipal Board, this City, by virtue of Art. 3, Sec. 14, of Republic Act No. 179.

This office should not have vetoed this Resolution because, like the members of the Board, the undersigned desires to give the new Municipal Board an opportunity to look into the organization of the City government for the purpose of greater efficiency and collective improvements. This requires, however, intense, impassioned and thorough study. But simultaneous and subsequent resolutions of the Board e.g., Res. No. 1 and other allied resolutions have already begun the reorganization which is the purpose of this resolution, without delving deeper into the framework of the City government making this resolution practically extinct and useless.

Done in the City Hall of Ormoc City, on this 8th day of January, in the Year of Our Lord, Nineteen Hundred and Fifty-Two.
